Hosea 1

An Awkward start

- The book of fury and forgiveness
- **Hosea & Gomer** –
 - Hosea is instructed to take a prostitute as a wife to symbolise the unfaithful ways of the nation of Israel
 - They have 3 children which have prophetic names that tell of the destruction of Israel, the salvation of Judah and the scattering of both kingdoms



vs 2 “The beginning of the word of the Lord by Hosea. And the Lord said to Hosea, Go, take unto thee a wife of whoredoms and children of whoredoms: for the land hath committed great whoredom, *departing from the Lord.*”

vs 10

“....and it shall come to pass, that in the place where it was said unto them, *Ye are not my people*, there it shall be said unto them, *Ye are the sons of the living God.*”

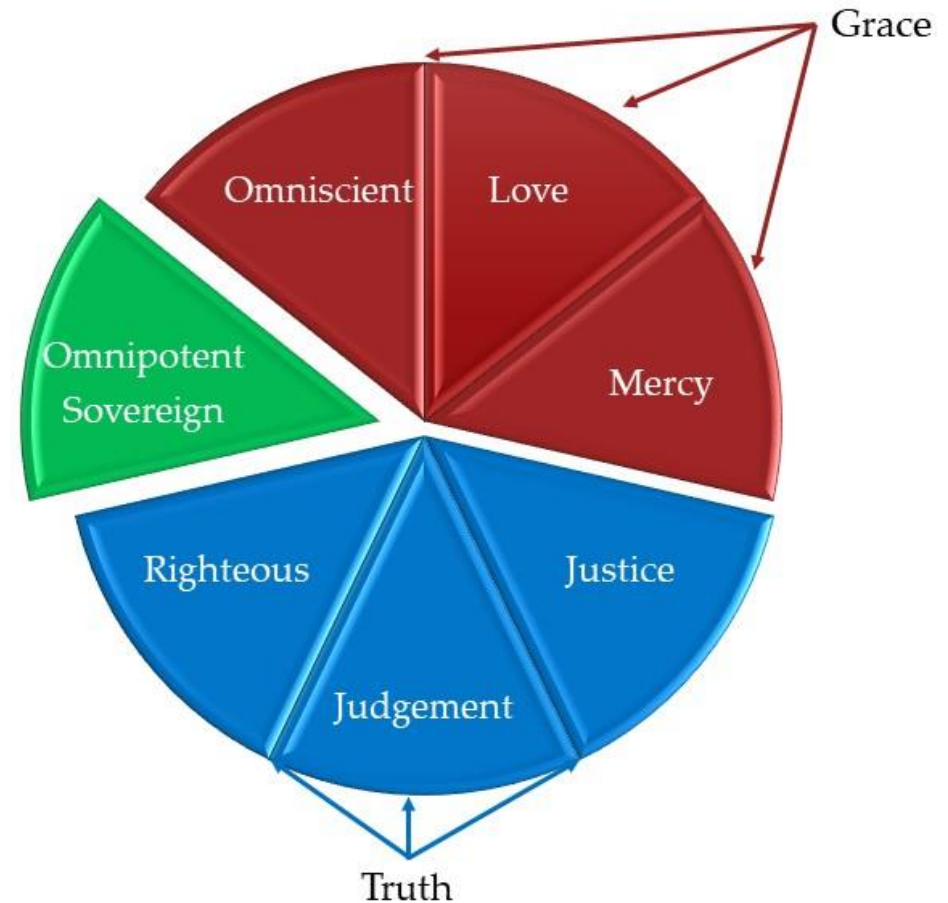
1 John 3:1

Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God:

Hosea 2

Cast away and Sought again

- God has had enough
 - Israel have taken everything he gave them and offered it to other Gods
 - They have also said they earned it themselves
 - So God withdraws his hand
- Yet God calls to them when they are in despair and offers them forgiveness



vs 19

*“And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in **righteousness**, and in **judgment**, and in **lovingkindness**, and in **mercies**.”*

- We see how God’s very nature is designed for our protection and setup to bring about a perfect relationship with him

Hosea 3

Bought back in 5 verses

- **God & Hosea Paralleled**—
 - Hosea is sent to buy back Gomer
 - God himself bought us through the blood of his perfect son **Jesus**
- Israel will return to God in the **latter days**

vs 17

*Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the Lord their God, and **David their king**; and shall fear the Lord and his goodness in the **latter days**.*

Zechariah 11:12-13

¹² And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver.

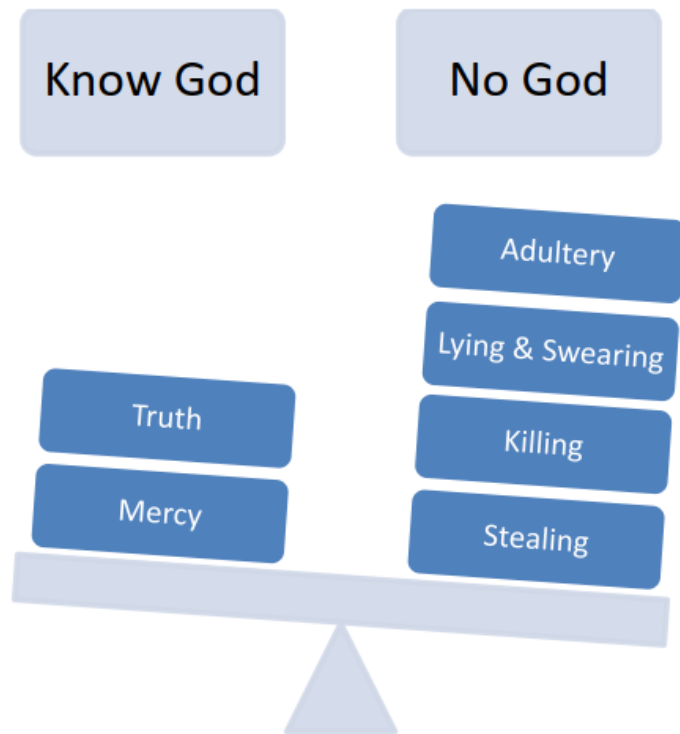

Hosea 4

Laying the Charges:

- Israel have left the ways of the Lord
- They have abandoned the desire for the truth
- God will not even bother to stop them



Romans 1:20-25

²⁰ For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

²¹ Because that, when they knew God, **they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful**; but **became vain in their imaginations**, and their foolish heart was darkened.

²² Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

²³ And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

²⁴ Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:

²⁵ Who changed the truth of God into a lie, **and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator**, who is blessed for ever. Amen.
