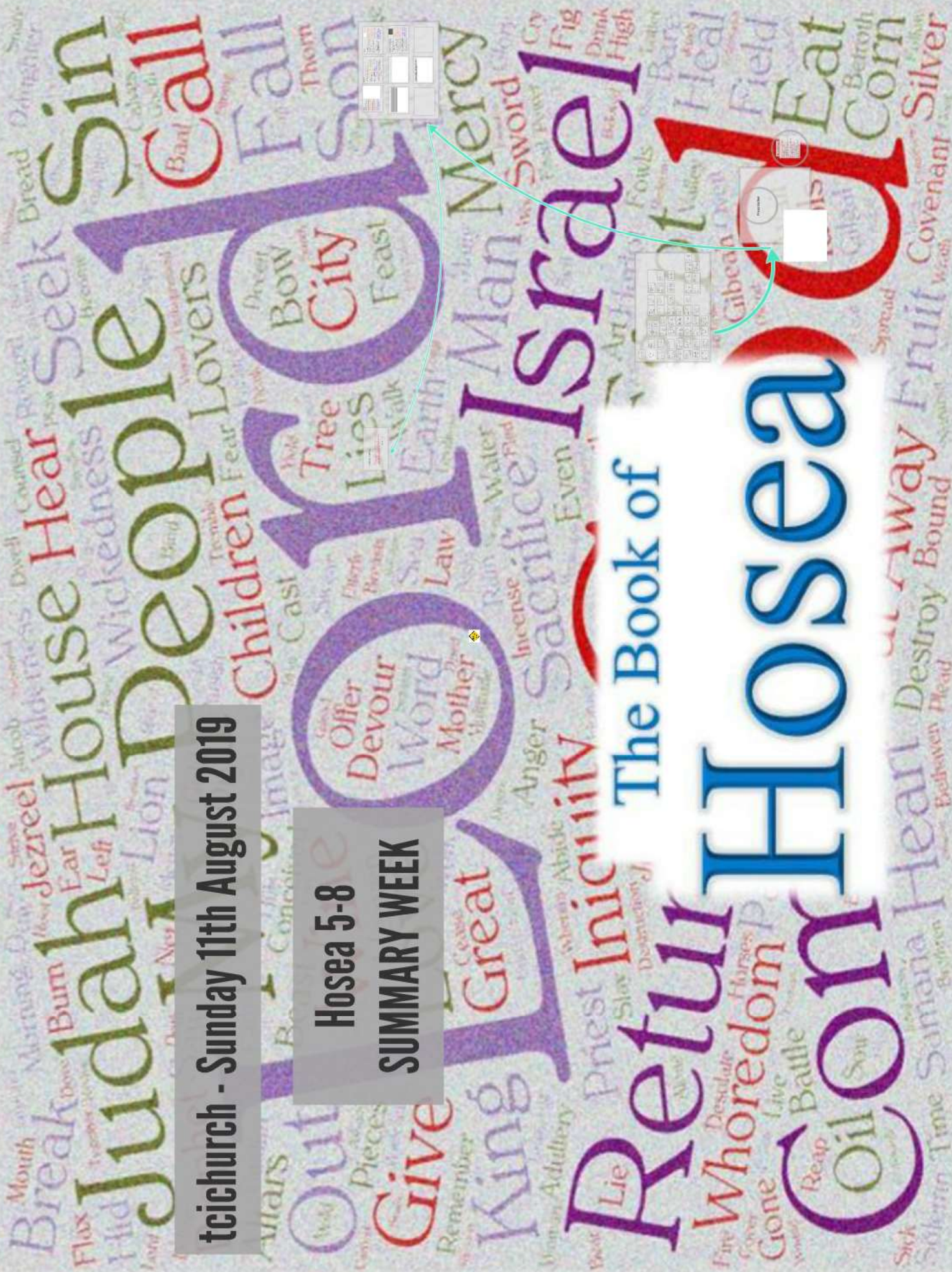

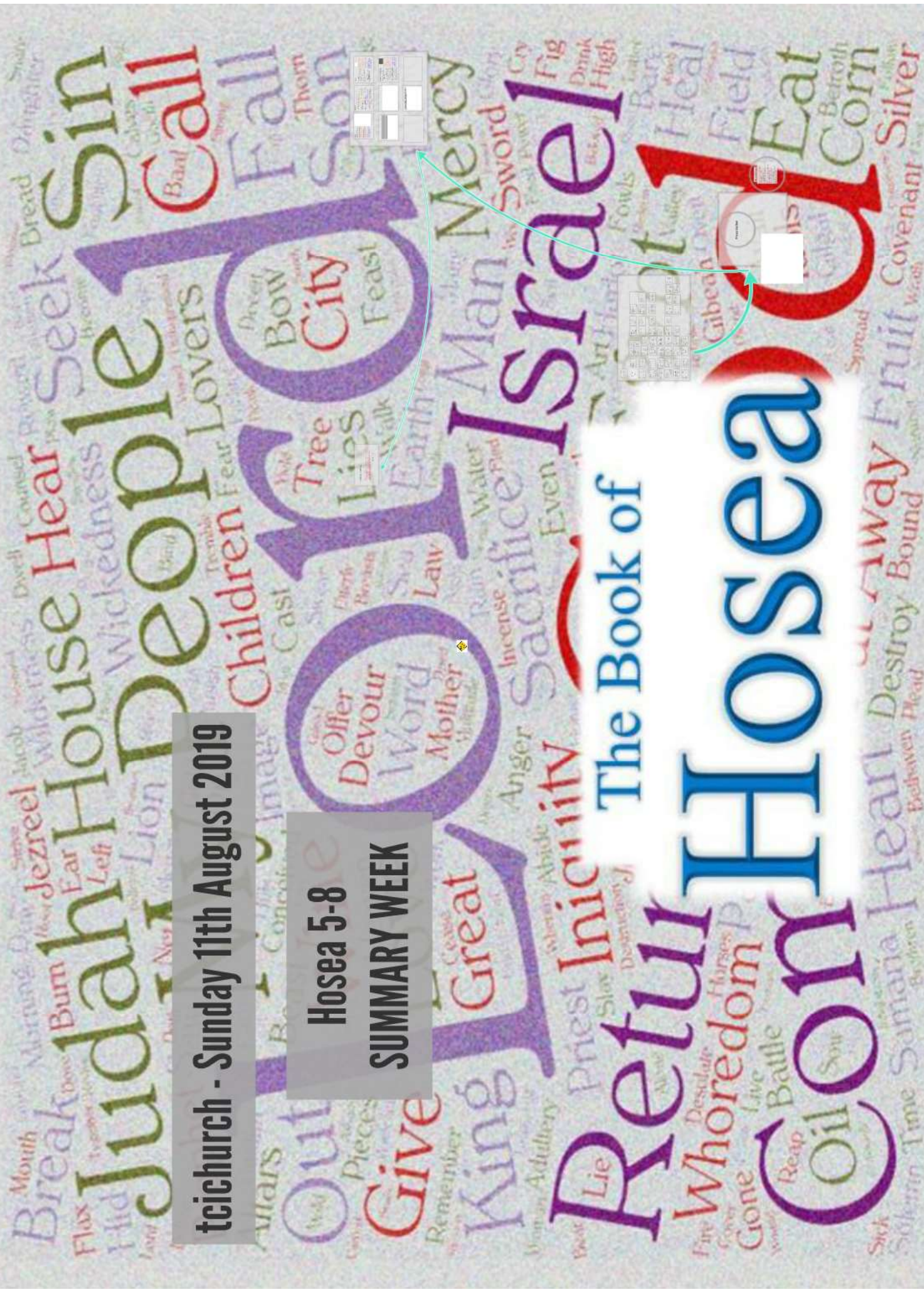

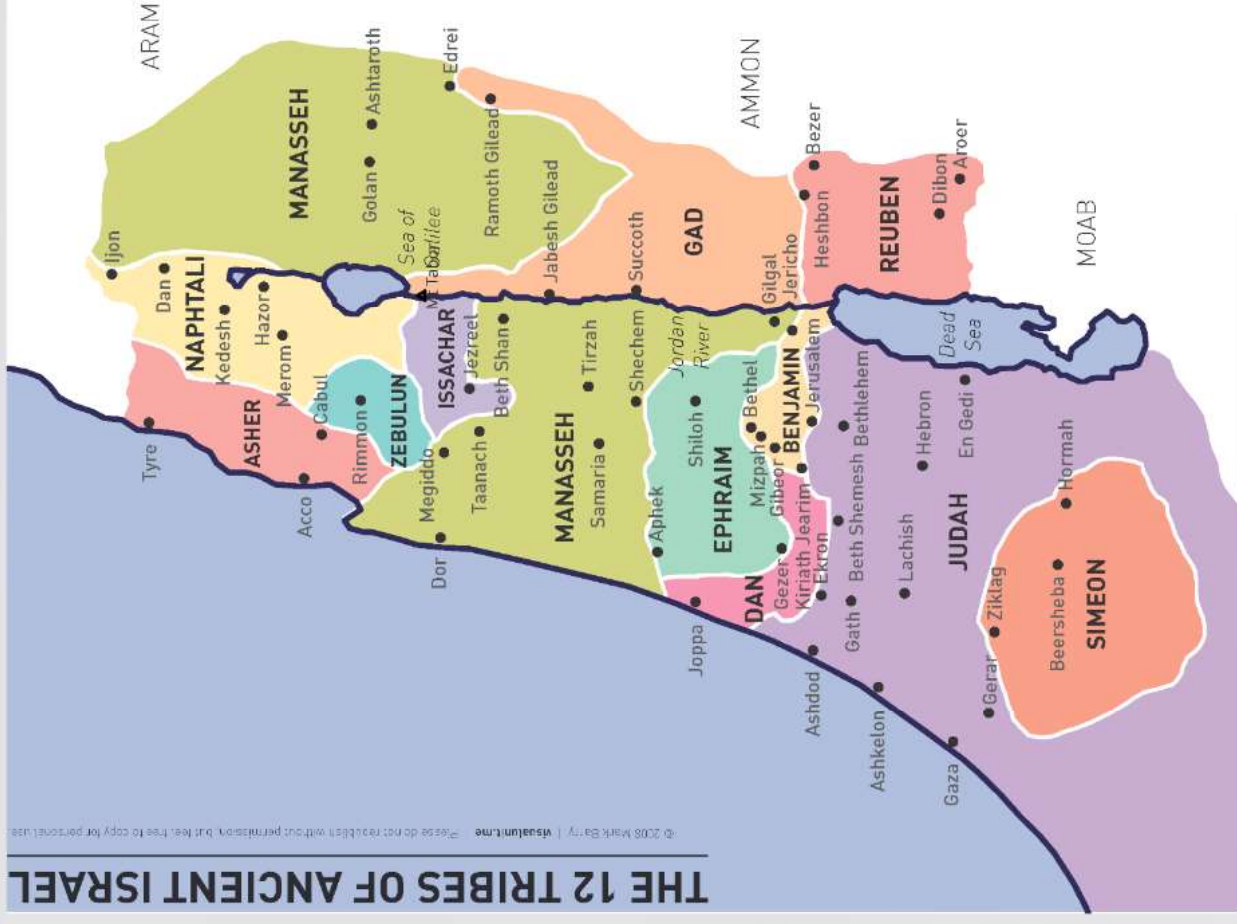
Hosea 5

... Following from Hosea 4:
"no knowledge of God in the land"

Living in a world that doesn't know God but this doesn't mean he doesn't know us
5:3 I know Ephraim, and Israel is not hid from me: for now, O Ephraim, thou committest whoredom, and Israel is defiled.

But Pride cometh before the fall:
5:5 And the pride of Israel doth testify to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity: Judah also shall fall with them.

God Withdraws
5:15 I will go and return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.
(in their misery they will earnestly seek me.)



John 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

Hosea 6

The faithful commitment is still there, God still wants that relationship with his people!

In our misery and remorse we seek the Lord

1 Come, and let us return unto the Lord: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up.

We now live in the time when Jesus can revive us and we can be RIGHTEOUS in Gods sight

2 After two days will he revive us: in the third day he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight.

BUT even after becoming righteous we need follow the Lord to know him and he will guide us by his spirit

3 Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the Lord: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

"knowledge" or "Yada" is not more than intellectual but a relationship. God above all things wants a relationship with us. ...

6 For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

Hosea 7

- Despite God's mercy and forgiveness toward his people they are false toward him and forget that God knows their hearts
- They are still proud and fail to call upon him, instead the look for help in the wrong places
- Even after all God has done, they don't seek him, they want the provision of God but then rebel against God



v8 Ephraim is a cake not turned.

7:1 When I would have healed Israel... they commit falsehood; and the thief cometh in, and the troop of robbers spoileth without.
7:2 And they consider not in their hearts that I remember all their wickedness

7:10 And the pride of Israel testifieth to his face: and they do not return to the Lord their God, nor seek him for all this.

7:11 Ephraim also is like a silly dove without heart: they call to Egypt, they go to Assyria.

7:13...though I have redeemed them, yet they have spoken lies against me.

7:14 And they have not cried unto me with their heart, when they howled upon their beds: they assemble themselves for corn and wine, and they rebel against me.

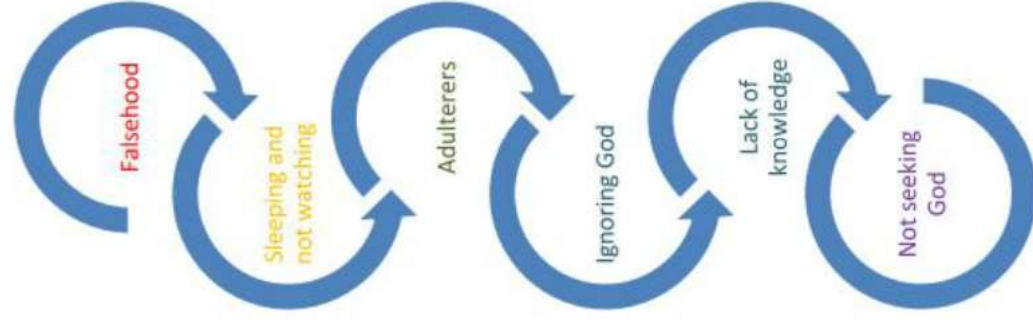
Psalm 144:[11] Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood:

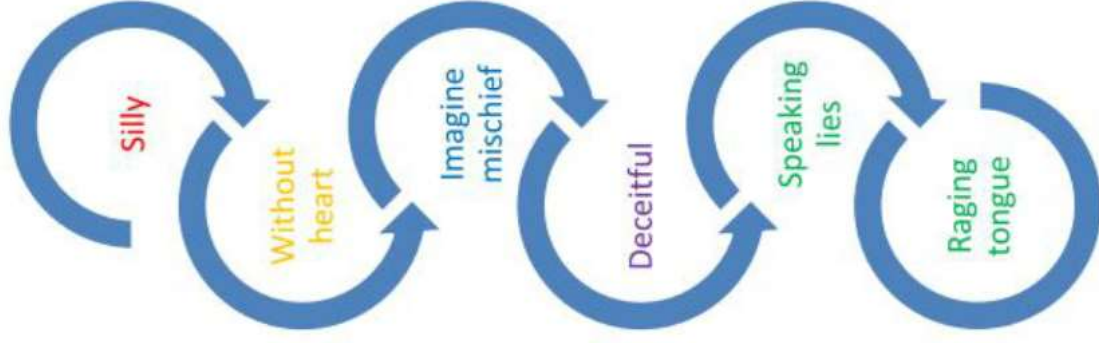
Matt 26:[40] And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them asleep, and saith unto Peter, What, could ye not watch with me one hour? **[41]** Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

1 Cor 6:[9] Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

Hosea 4:6 - My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

2 Chronicles 7:14 - If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.





Job 5:[2] For wrath killeth the foolish man, and envy slayeth the silly one.

Prov 4:[23] Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

Psalms 62:[3] How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you:.....
[5] My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him.

Prov 11:[18] The wicked worketh a deceitful work: but to him that soweth righteousness shall be a sure reward.

Matt 12:[36] But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. [37] For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

Hosea 8 - Israel is Scattered

- The Trumpet is blown, the day of trouble comes. The people cry out to God.

Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

- It is time for them to reap what they sow, they have removed God's truth from their lives, the Law has become a "strange thing"

1 Sam 8:8 According to all the works which they have done since the day that I brought them up out of Egypt even unto this day, wherewith they have forsaken me, and served other gods, so do they also unto thee.

- Israel has been returned to bondage, God's focus for a scattered remnant of Israel now rests in promises of his new covenant

Hebrews 8:10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.



8:2 Israel shall cry unto me, My God, we know thee.

...

8:4 They have set up kings, but not by me: they have made princes, and I knew it not:

8:7 For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind:

8:12 I have written to him the great things of my law, but they were counted as a strange thing.

8:13 They sacrifice flesh for the sacrifices of mine offerings, and eat it; but the LORD accepteth them not; now will he remember their iniquity, and visit their sins: they shall return to Egypt.

8:14 For Israel hath forgotten his Maker,

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

1. Prophecy

- a. Take the book of Daniel
- b. Jesus' fulfillment of hundreds of prophecies in his life

2. Unity

- a. 66 books written by 40 or more authors
- b. written by different types of people
- c. written in different points in history
