



Common ancestry – Timothy maternal mother was a Jewess and shared Israelite heritage with Paul

unfeigned = *sincere*, *not divided*

Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. Isaiah 41:10

¹³ Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.


¹⁴ That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.
