Haggai Chapter 1

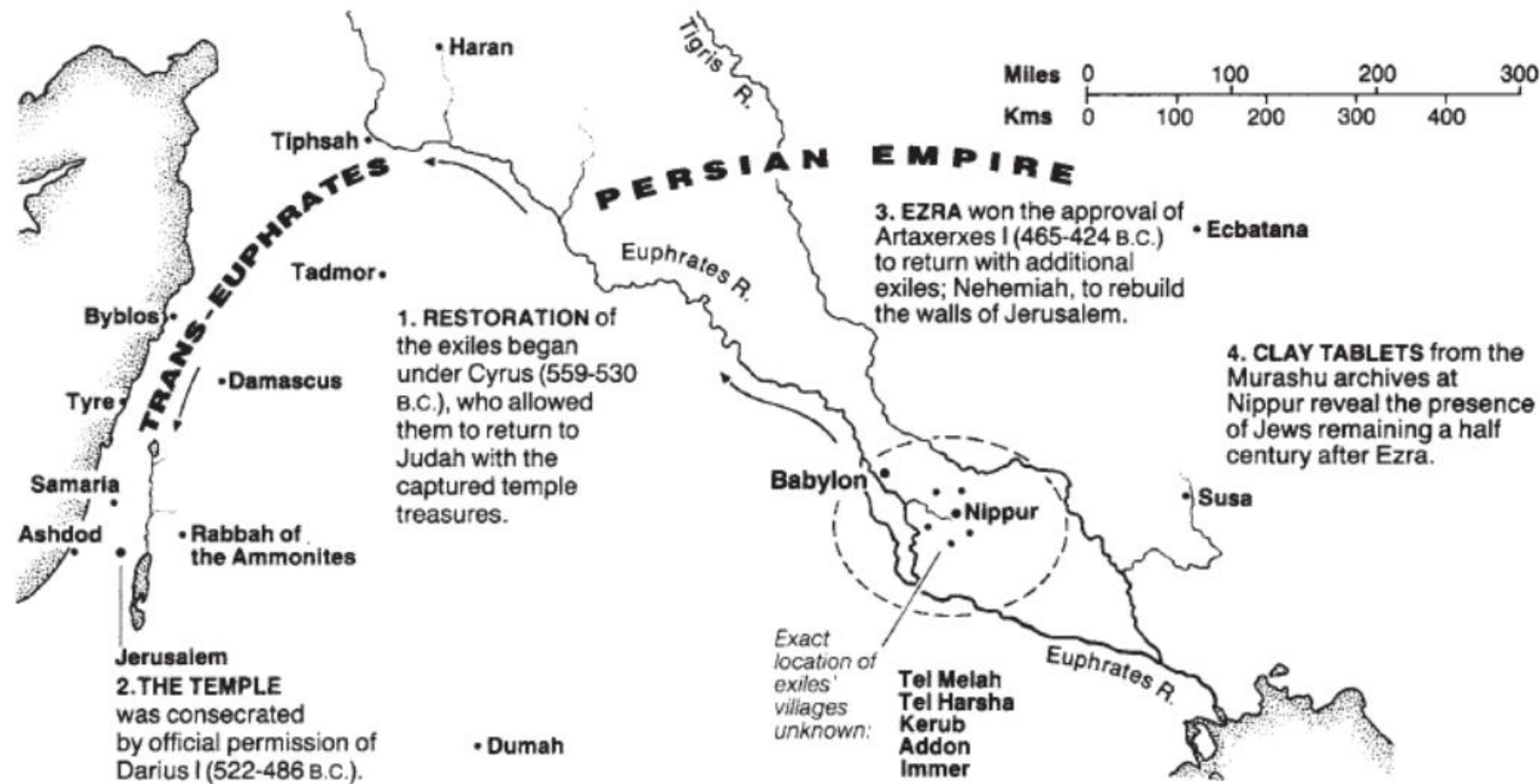
Fast Facts:

- Written about 520 BC after Darius came to power
- Is 2 chapters in length
- Reinforces the importance of building the temple again after the work had been stopped because of the lies of the non Jewish people.

In the second year of Darius the king, in the sixth month, in the first day of the month, came the word of the LORD by **Haggai the prophet** unto **Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah**, and to **Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest**, saying,

² Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, This people say, The time is not come, the time that the LORD's house should be built.

³ Then came the word of the LORD by Haggai the prophet, saying,

⁴ Is it time for you, O ye, to dwell in your cieled houses, and this house lie waste?

⁵ Now therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts;

Consider your ways.

⁶ Ye have sown much, and bring in little; **ye eat**, but ye have not enough; **ye drink**, but ye are not filled with drink; **ye clothe** you, but there is none warm; and **he that earneth wages earneth wages to put it into a bag with holes.**

⁷ Thus saith the LORD of hosts; **Consider your ways.**

⁸ Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the LORD.

⁹ Ye looked for much, and, lo it came to little; and when ye brought it home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the LORD of hosts. Because of mine house that is waste, and ye run every man unto his own house.

¹⁰ Therefore the heaven over you is stayed from dew, and the earth is stayed from her fruit.

“This is again very much the language of the wisdom books.

The fear of the Lord and his blessing are matters of daily life, to do with house and family, work and food.. Not that these psalms are taking us back to the uncomplicated world of Psalm 1 and 37 where good is always rewarded and evil punished. By this point in the psalter, and by the time of the return from exile, the composers and singers of these songs had long since lost any naivety they may once have had.

Experience had taught them that Psalm 1 often seemed wrong; deeper experience had taught them that it was always right in the end.”
