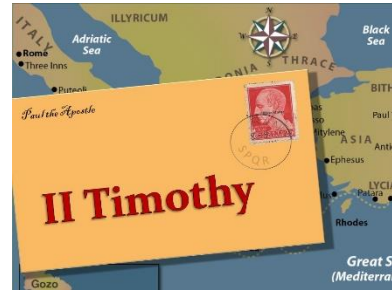


2 Timothy Chapters 1-4

Series Study Sheet



Chapter 1 Grace, mercy and peace

[5] I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee,
Read 2 Tim 2:5-6 **What does this statement mean, how has Timothy obtained this faith and why is it important to us?**

[13] Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. Read Titus 1:9, 1 Tim 6:3-4, 2 Tim 2:6-7
What are the main points we must be mindful of if we are to hold fast the form of sound words?

[8] Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;
Read Eph 3:1 and 2 Tim 2:15-16
What are some challenges we might face today when we must show we are not ashamed of the testimony of our Lord?

Chapter 2 Entangled in the affairs of this life

[9]...the word of God is not bound
Read verses 9-10 and 1 Thess 5:9
Can you think of examples that show that despite Paul being bound the word of God is not bound?

[15] Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Read 1 Peter 3:15 and 1 Cor 15:51-54 **Why do we need to study the word of God? Can you see a connection between the verse from Corinthians and ‘rightly dividing the word of truth’**

Read John 14:2-3, 2 Tim 2:20-21 and Rom 9:21 **Discuss the connection between these verses. How does 2 Tim 2:21 direct us about what we should be striving for?**

Chapter 3 in the last days perilous times shall come

Read 2 Tim 3:1-5

Can you give examples of ‘Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof’

Read 2 Tim 3:7, Titus 1:16, 1 John 2:4 **What is the ultimate goal that is expressed in these verses?**

What character traits does Paul list in 2 Tim 3:10?

Chapter 4 The quick and the dead

Read 2 Tim 4:1, Acts 10:42 and 1 Thess 4:13-18

What does Paul mean by ‘the quick and the dead’? How does this distinction relate to the previous verse ‘rightly dividing the word of truth’?

Read 2 Tim 4:3-5. What does Paul mean by ‘itching ears’? How can we avoid turning away from the truth?

Read 2 Tim 4:8, 1 Cor 15:41, Rev 2:10. What is the crown of righteousness laid up for Paul?
