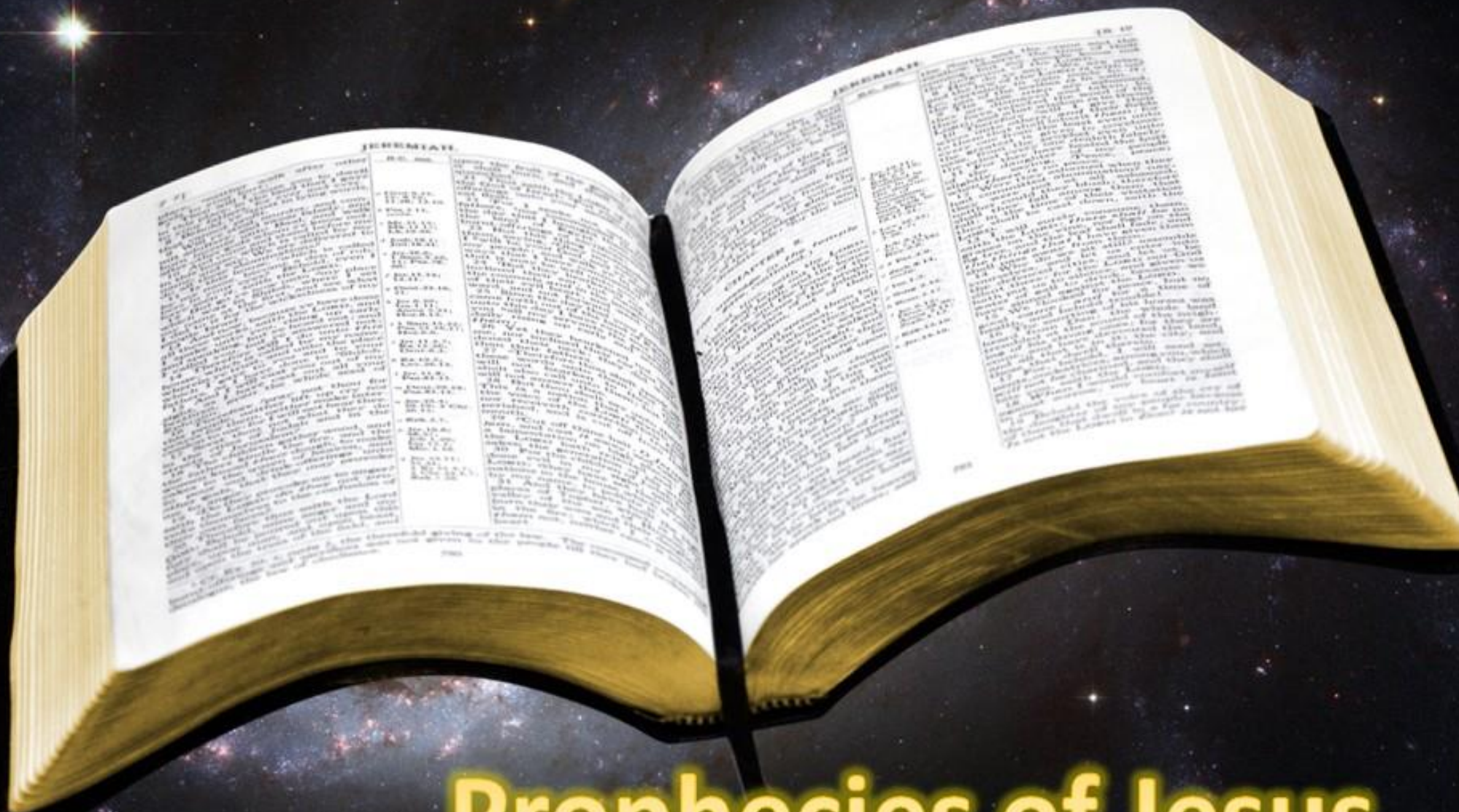

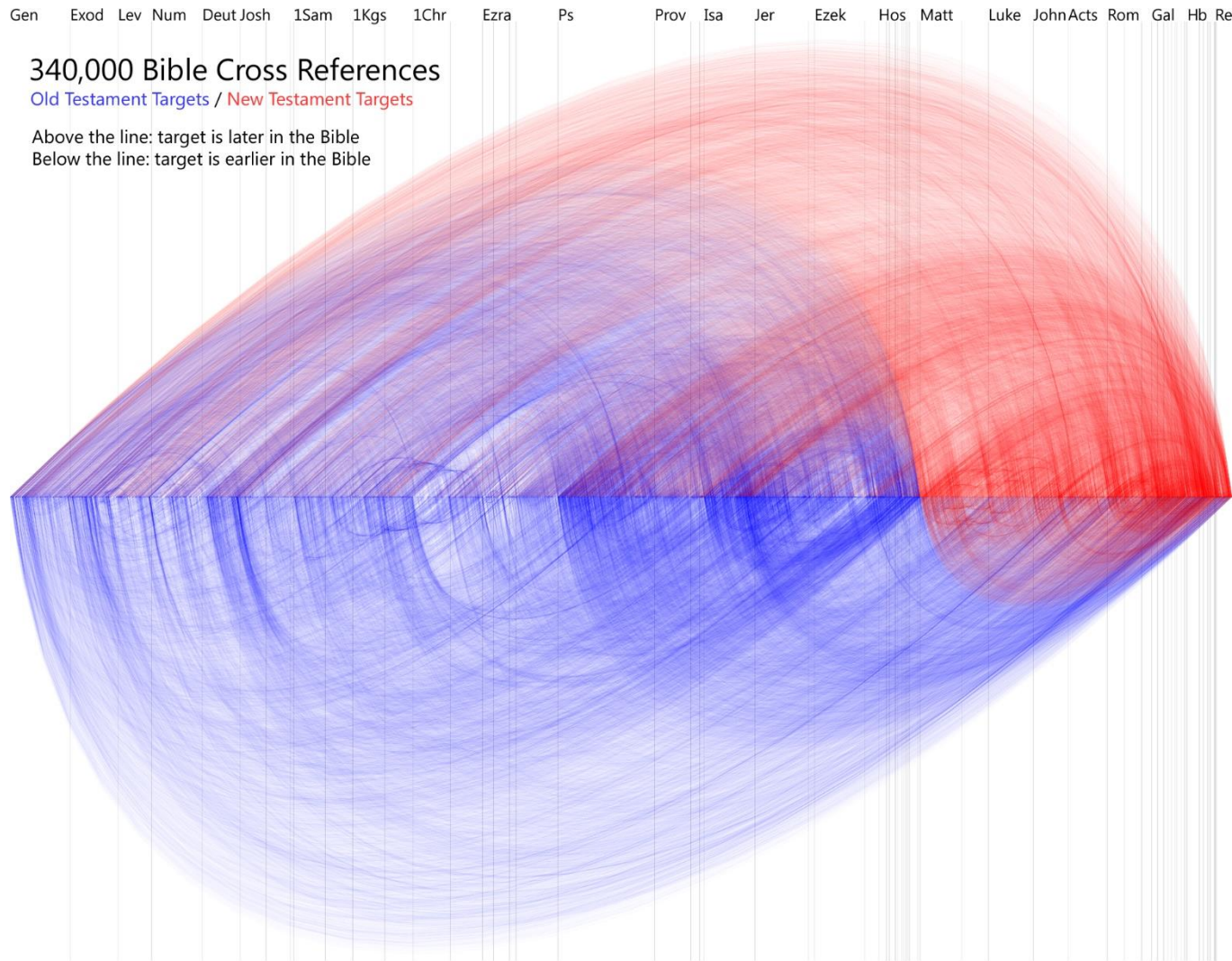
# The Bible
