






Matthew Chapter 24:23-51

Do not be deceived

- ²³ Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not.
- ²⁴ For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- ²⁵ Behold, I have told you before.



- ²⁶ Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not.
- ²⁷ For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.
- ²⁸ For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.



The Destruction of the world

- ²⁹ Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:
- ³⁰ And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- 31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Ezekiel 37:9-11

- ⁹ Then said he unto me, Prophesy unto the wind, prophesy, son of man, and say to the wind, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.
- ¹⁰ So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood up upon their feet, an exceeding great army.
- ¹¹ Then he said unto me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost: we are cut off for our parts.

Revelations 7:1-4 (7-9)

And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

- ² And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,
- ³ Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.
- ⁴ And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.

How will it come?

- ³² Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh:
- ³³ So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors.
- ³⁴ Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.
- ³⁵ Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
- ³⁶ But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.
- ³⁷ But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.
- ³⁸ For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,
- ³⁹ And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.





Genesis 6:8,9

- ⁸ But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.
- ⁹ These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.
- ¹¹ The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.
- ¹² And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

The Great Divide

- ⁴⁰ Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.
- ⁴¹ Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.



Romans 2:5-11

- ⁵ But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;
- ⁶ Who will render to every man according to his deeds:
- ⁷ To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life:
- ⁸ But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,
- ⁹ Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;
- ¹⁰ But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile:
- ¹¹ For there is no respect of persons with God.

Always Ready

- ⁴² Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.
- ⁴³ But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up.
- ⁴⁴ Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

- ⁴⁵ Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?
- ⁴⁶ Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- ⁴⁷ Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods.

- ⁴⁸ But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming;
- ⁴⁹ And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken;
- ⁵⁰ The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of,
- ⁵¹ And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
