The Gospel According to Matthew



Matthew Chapter 25

The 10 virgins

[1] Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto **ten virgins**, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.

[2] And five of them were wise, and five were foolish.

[3] They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

Psalm 5: [5] The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.

[4] But **the wise took oil in their vessels**

with their lamps.

[5] While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.

‘To the law and to the testimony : if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.’, Isa. viii. 20.

"The commandment is a lamp; and the law is light." Prov. vi. 23.

[6] And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him.

[7] Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps.

[8] And the foolish said unto the wise,
Give us of your oil; for our lamps are
gone out.

[9] But the wise answered, saying, Not
so; lest there be not enough for us and
you: but go ye rather to them that sell,
and buy for yourselves.

[10] And while they went to buy, the
bridegroom came; and they that were
ready went in with him to the marriage:
and the door was shut.

[11] Afterward came also the other
virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us.

[12] But he answered and said, Verily I
say unto you, I know you not.

[13] Watch therefore, for ye know

neither the day nor the hour wherein the
Son of man cometh.

The Talents

[14] For the kingdom of heaven is as a
man travelling into a far country, who
called his own servants, and delivered
unto them his goods.

[15] And unto one he gave five talents,
to another two, and to another one; to
every man according to his several
ability; and straightway took his journey.

[16] Then he that had received the five
talents went and traded with the same,
and made them other five talents.

[17] And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.

[18] But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

[19] After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

[20] And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

[21] His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, **I will make thee ruler over many things: enter**

thou into the joy of thy lord.

John 15:[10] If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

[11] These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.

[22] He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them.

[23] His lord said unto him, Well done,

good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, **I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.**

[24] Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:

[25] And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.

[26] His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:

[27] Thou oughtest therefore to have put

my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.

[28] Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.

[29] For **unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.**

[30] And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Luke 16:[20] And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,

[21] And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

[22] And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;

[23] And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

[24] And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

[25] But Abraham said, Son, remember that

thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.

[26] And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.

[27] Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house:

[28] For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.

[29] Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.

[30] And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.

[31] And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead.
