

thy name.


Thy kingdom come.


**7** **And there was war in heaven**: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,

### **Luke 9:55**


But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, **Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of.**

**3** But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, **Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.**

**4** And the serpent said unto the woman, **Ye shall not surely die:**

**5** For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

**6** And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one

wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

**7** And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

**8** And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

**9** And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?

**10** And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

**11** And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

**12** And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.

**13** And the LORD God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.

**14** And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:

**15** And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

**16** Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

**17** And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life;

**18** Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field;

**19** In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.

**20** And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.

## John 11

**1** Now a certain man was sick, named Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha....

**3** Therefore his sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom thou lovest is sick.

**4** When Jesus heard that, he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.....

**11** Our friend Lazarus sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep.....

**17** Then when Jesus came, he found that he had lain in the grave four days already.

**18** Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off:

**19** And many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother.

**20** Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met him: but Mary sat still in the house.

**21** Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.

**22** But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee.

**23** Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

**24** Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.

**25** Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

**26** And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

**27** She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

**28** And when she had so said, she went her way, and called Mary her sister secretly, saying, The Master is come, and calleth for thee.....

**32** Then when Mary was come where Jesus was, and saw him, she fell down at his feet, saying unto him, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.

**33** When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled.

**34** And said, Where have ye laid him? They said unto him, Lord, come and see.

**35** Jesus wept.

**36** Then said the Jews, Behold how he loved him!

**37** And some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died?

**38** Jesus therefore again groaning in himself cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it.

**39** Jesus said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days.

**40** Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?

**41** Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

**42** And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which

stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me.

**43** And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.

**44** And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

**45** Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and had seen the things which Jesus did, believed on him.
