The Gospel of John

John Chapter 1

Who art thou?

[18] No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

[19] And this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?

[20] And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.

[21] And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. *Art thou that prophet?* And he answered, No.

Deut 18:[15] *The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet* from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;

[16] According to all that thou desiredst of

the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not.

[17] And the LORD said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken.

[18] I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.

[19] And it shall come to pass, that **whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.**

John 6: [12] When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.

[13] Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained

over and above unto them that had eaten.
[14] Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, **This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.**

Acts3: [20] And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you:

[21] Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

[22] For Moses truly said unto the fathers, **A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you** of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.

[23] **And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.**

[22] Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?

[23] He said, I am the voice of one crying

in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, **as said the prophet Esaias.**

Isaiah 40: [3] The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God.

[24] And they which were sent were of the Pharisees.

I come baptizing with water

[25] And they asked him, and said unto him, Why baptizest thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet?

[26] John answered them, saying, I baptize with water: but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not;

[27] He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet

I am not worthy to unloose.

Behold the Lamb of god

[28] These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

[29] The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.**

[30] This is he of whom I said, **After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me.**

John 8: [56] Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.

[57] Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham?

[58] Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

[31] And I knew him not: but that he

should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am **I come baptizing with water.**

[32] And John bare record, saying, **I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.**

Isaiah 42

[1] Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles.

he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost

[33] And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see **the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.**

Luke 3: [22] And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

Matt 3: [16] And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

Mark 1: [10] And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him:

[34] And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God.

[35] Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;

[36] And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!

Lev 17: [10] And whatsoever man there be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of blood; I will even set my face against that soul that eateth blood, and will cut him off from among his people.

[11] For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

[12] Therefore I said unto the children of Israel, No soul of you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger that sojourneth among you eat blood.

[13] And whatsoever man there be of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, which hunteth and catcheth any beast or fowl that may be eaten; he shall even pour out the blood thereof, and cover it with dust.

[14] For it is the life of all flesh; the blood of it is for the life thereof: therefore I said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall eat the blood of no manner of flesh: for the life of

all flesh is the blood thereof: whosoever eateth it shall be cut off.

Gen 9:[4] But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat.

[5] And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man.

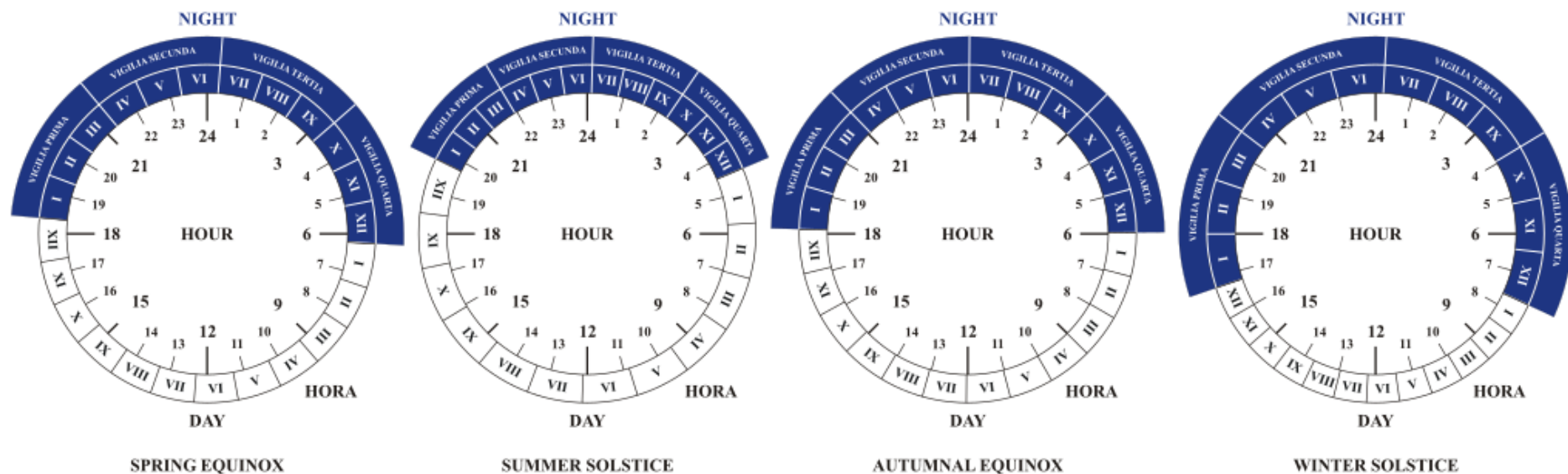
Exod 12: **[5]** Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year

Hebrews 9:[22] and without shedding of blood is no remission.

[37] And the two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.

[38] Then Jesus turned, and saw them following, and saith unto them, What seek ye? They said unto him, Rabbi, (which is to say, being interpreted, Master,) where dwellest thou?

[39] He saith unto them, Come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for **it was about the tenth hour.**

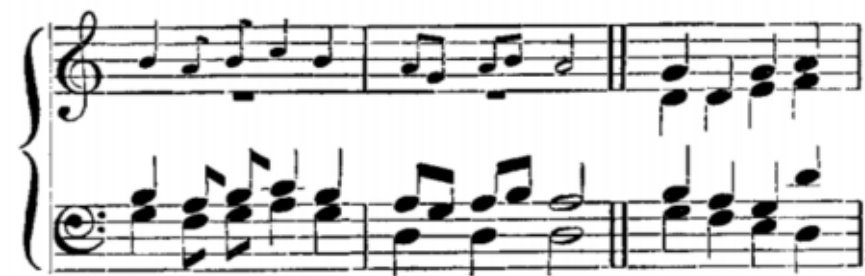
