Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.







# The Pool(s) of Bethesda








The Hebrew word Beth hesda means "house of mercy" or "house of grace." In Hebrew and Aramaic it could also mean "shame" or "disgrace."

**John 5:[2]** Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep market a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches.





### Luke 14

[16] .. A certain man made a great supper, and bade many:

[17] And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.

[18] And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

[19] And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.


[20] And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.

[21] So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind.

[22] And the servant said, Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room.

[23] And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.

[24] For I say unto you, That none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper.


[1] After this there was a feast of the Jews; and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

### The Pools of Bethesda

[2] Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep

## market a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches.

[3] In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.



[4] For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.

### Jesus heals on the sabbath day

[5] And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.

- [6] When Jesus saw him lie, and knew that he had been now a long time in that case, he saith unto him, Wilt thou be made whole?
- [7] The impotent man answered him, Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool: but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me.
- [8] Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.
- [9] And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.

### The Jews start an inquisition

- [10] The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry thy bed.
- [11] He answered them, He that made me whole, the same said unto me, Take up thy bed, and walk.
- [12] Then asked they him, What man is that which said unto thee, Take up thy bed, and walk?
- [13] And he that was healed wist not who it was:

for Jesus had conveyed himself away, a multitude being in that place.

### sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee

- [14] Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.
- [15] The man departed, and told the Jews that it was Jesus, which had made him whole.
- [16] And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.
- [17] But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.
- [18] Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.

### Jesus' defence

[19] Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also

#### doeth the Son likewise.

- [20] For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.
- [21] For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.
- [22] For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:
- [23] That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.
- [24] Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

  [25] Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.
- [26] For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath

he given to the Son to have life in himself;

- [27] And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
- [28] Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,
- [29] And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

### 2 Samuel 5

- [6] And the king and his men went to Jerusalem unto the Jebusites, the inhabitants of the land: which spake unto David, saying, Except thou take away the blind and the lame, thou shalt not come in hither: thinking, David cannot come in hither.
- [7] Nevertheless David took the strong hold of Zion: the same is the city of David.
- [8] And David said on that day, Whosoever getteth up to the gutter, and smiteth the Jebusites,

and the lame and the blind, that are hated of David's soul, he shall be chief and captain.

Wherefore they said, The blind and the lame shall not come into the house.

### Matt.11

- [1] And it came to pass, when Jesus had made an end of commanding his twelve disciples, he departed thence to teach and to preach in their cities.
- [2] Now when John had heard in the prison the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples,
- [3] And said unto him, Art thou he that should come, or do we look for another?
- [4] Jesus answered and said unto them, Go and shew John again those things which ye do hear and see:
- [5] The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.
- [6] And blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me.
