



Acts 12:1-19

Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church.

- ² And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.
- ³ And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. (Then were the days of unleavened bread.)
- ⁴ And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people.
- ⁵ Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.

Herod Agrippa I

- ²¹ And upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his throne, and made an oration unto them.
- ²² And the people gave a shout, saying, It is the voice of a god, and not of a man.
- ²³ And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost.

James the greater

- One of the first disciples
- Witnessed the transfiguration
- The first to be martyred of the 12 disciples

Easter – pascha (Strong's G3957)
(28x Passover, 1x Easter)

⁶ And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison.

⁷ And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon him, and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from his hands.


⁸ And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me.



Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.



Tongues and Interpretation

1 Corinthians 14:27-28

²⁷ If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret.

²⁸ But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God.

Prophecy

Deuteronomy 18:20-22

²⁰ But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.

²¹ And if thou say in thine heart, How shall we know the word which the LORD hath not spoken?

²² When a prophet speaketh in the name of the LORD, if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD hath not spoken, but the prophet hath spoken it presumptuously: thou shalt not be afraid of him.

Healing

Acts 5:15-16

¹⁵ Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

¹⁶ There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

In summary for the Miraculous Gifts:

- We don't see these often today.
- We must be careful in getting carried away searching for these.
- When presented with claims of these happenings, remember the rules.

So, what happened?

Acts 8:5-8, 12, 14-17

- ⁵ Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them.
- ⁶ And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.
- ⁷ For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.
- ⁸ And there was great joy in that city.
- ¹² But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
- ¹⁴ Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John:
- ¹⁵ Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:

- ¹⁶ (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.)
- ¹⁷ Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.

Everything for His purpose:

- It appears that a limited number of people could give the Holy Ghost.
- It also appears that those that received the Holy Ghost could not pass it on to others.
- We have seen other times where the Holy Ghost has worked miracles to establish a message. A good example is the many prophecies, healings and miracles performed when the Christian Israelite Church was established.

So what's the point?

John 4:46-49

⁴⁶ So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum.

⁴⁷ When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death.

⁴⁸ Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

⁴⁹ The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, <u>come down</u> ere my child die.

"Belief" – is the critical thing and what we have Faith in.
