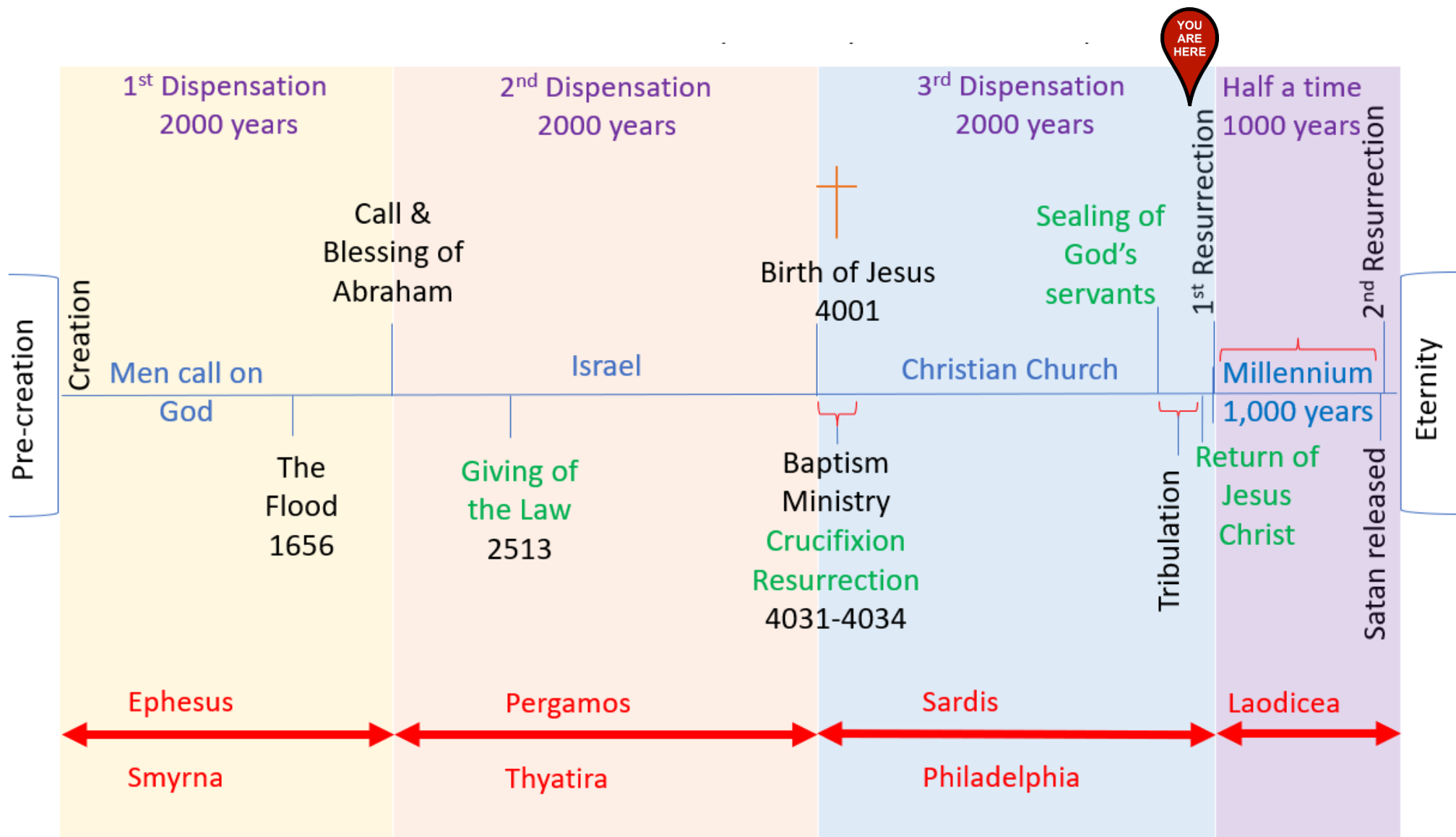

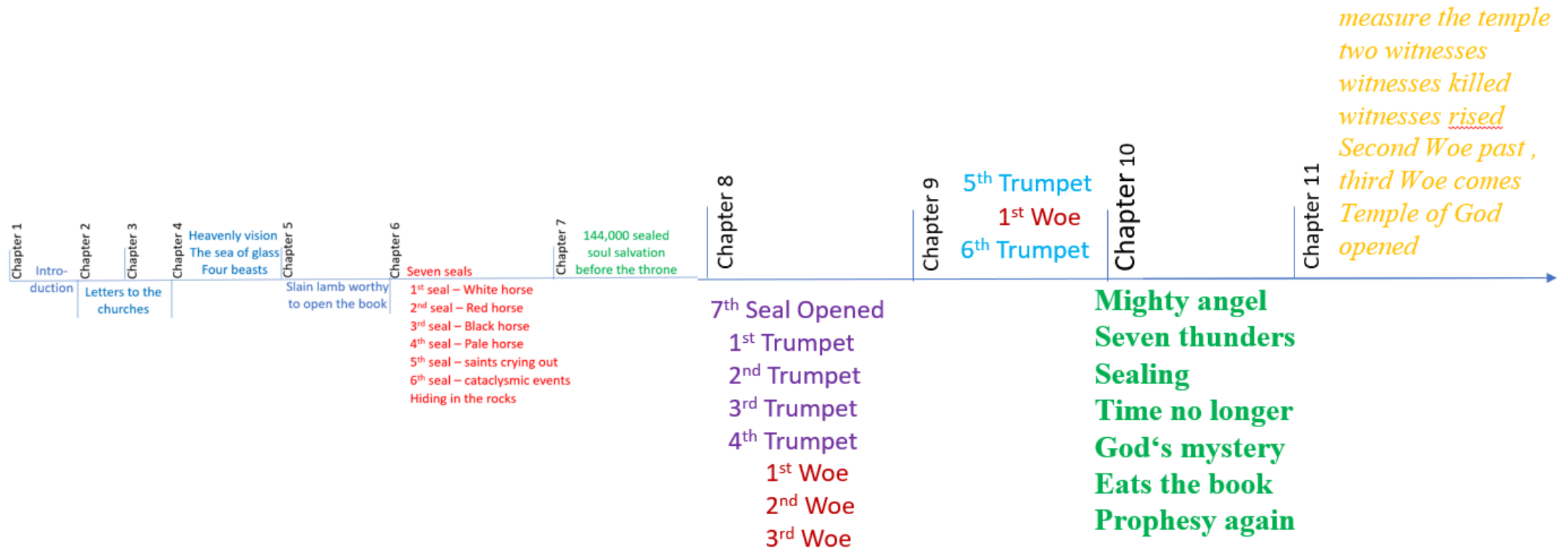

Revelation Chapter 10

A mighty angel

[1] And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

[2] And he had in his hand a little book open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,

Revelation 1:[12] And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;
[13] And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

[14] His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;

[15] And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

[16] And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

[17] And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

[18] I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Revelation 5:[1] And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

Revelation 4: [6] And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal

Revelation 15: [2] And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. [3] And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints

seven thunders uttered

[3] And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

Seal up those things

[4] And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write:

and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

Daniel 12:[4] But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Matthew 10:[26] Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.

[5] And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven,

there should be time no longer

[6] And sware by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and

the things that therein are, and the sea,
and the things which are therein, that
there should be time no longer:

The mystery of God finished

[7] But in the days of the voice of the
seventh angel, **when he shall begin to
sound, the mystery of God should be
finished, as he hath declared to his
servants the prophets.**

*I took the little book out of the angel's
hand, and ate it up*

[8] And the voice which I heard from
heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go
and take the little book which is open in
the hand of the angel which standeth upon
the sea and upon the earth.

[9] And I went unto the angel, and said
unto him, Give me the little book. And he
said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it

shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be
in thy mouth sweet as honey.

[10] And I took the little book out of the
angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in
my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as
I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

Thou must prophesy again

[11] And he said unto me, **Thou must
prophesy again before many peoples, and
nations, and tongues, and kings.**

Mark 4: [11] And he said unto them, **Unto you
it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom
of God:** but unto them that are without, all
these things are done in parables:

Daniel Chapter 12

[1] And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and **at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.**

[2] And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

[3] And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

[4] But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

[5] Then I Daniel looked, and, behold, there stood other two, the one on this side of the bank of the river, and the other on that side of the bank of the river.

[6] And one said to the man clothed in linen, which was upon the waters of the river, How long shall it be to the end of these wonders?

[7] And I heard the man clothed in linen, which was upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and swore by him that liveth for ever that it shall be for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these things shall be finished.

1 Corinthians 15: [51] Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

[52] In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

[53] For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

[54] So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

[55] O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

[56] The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.

[57] But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ
