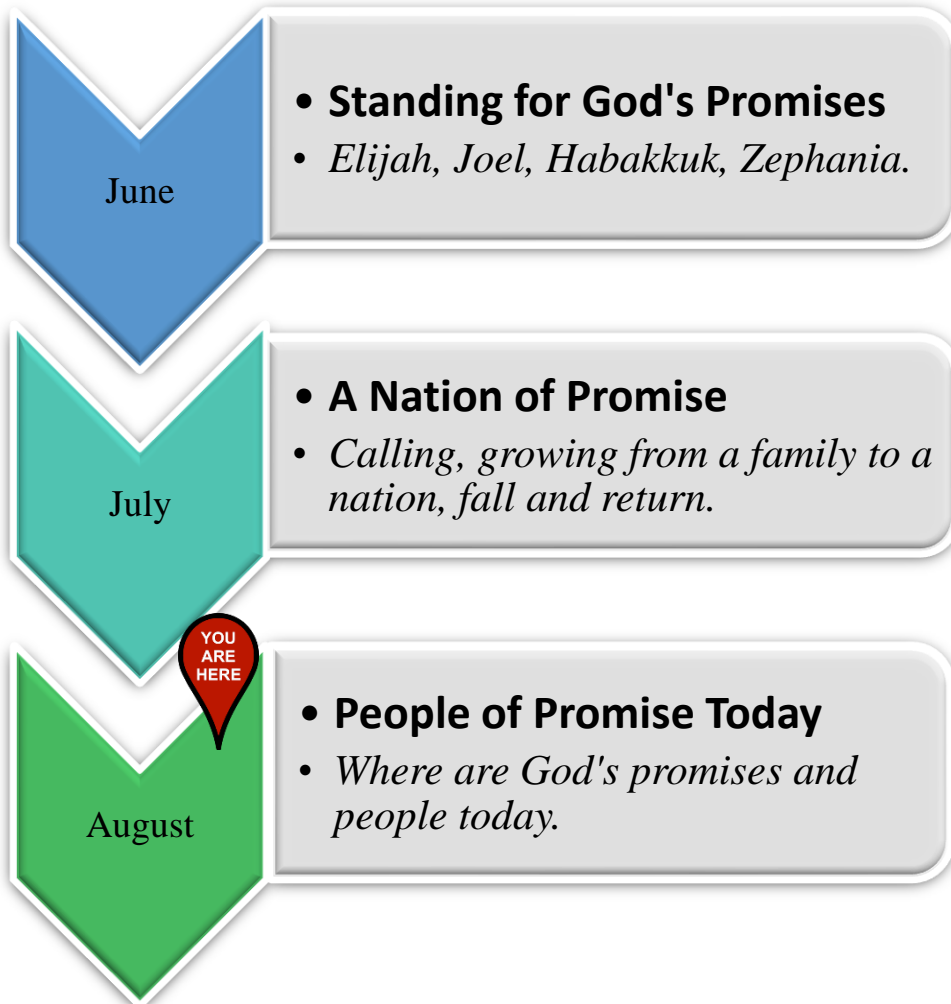

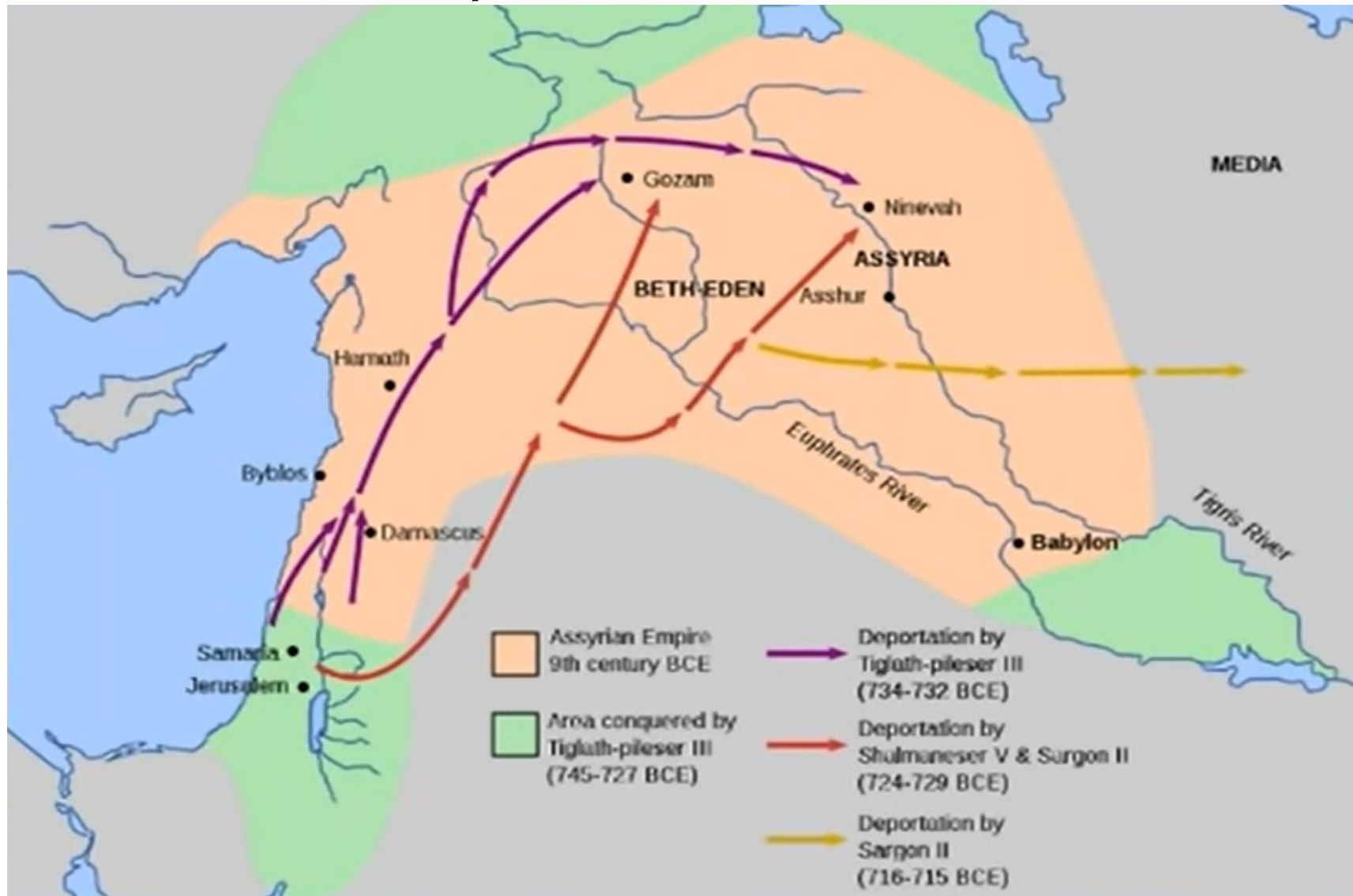

How Dispersed were the Tribes

According to current research, the Transjordanian and Galilean tribes witnessed massive expulsions, resulting in the loss of entire tribes. Historians generally conclude that the displaced tribes assimilated with the local population. In Samaria, on the other hand, many Israelites survived the Assyrian onslaught and remained there, eventually forming the Samaritan community....

Israel-Finkelstein estimated that during the two periods of deportation under Tiglath-Pileser III, Shalmaneser V, and Sargon II, only one-fifth of the population (about 40,000) was actually resettled from the area. Many also fled south to Jerusalem, which apparently expanded fivefold in size during this period, necessitating the construction of a new wall and the provision of a new water source (Siloam) by King Hezekiah. Furthermore, 2 Chronicles 30:1-11 specifically mentions how the northern Israelites saved by the Assyrians, especially the men of Dan, Ephraim, Manasseh, Asher, Zebulun, and the latter three, returned to worship at the Temple in Jerusalem at that time.

Another 900-1000 years later Europeans began migrating to, and in many cases came to rule, most areas in the world.

Many people have tried to find the ten tribes

- **Claims that the tribes relocated to Arabia, India, Nigeria, Ethiopia, Pakistan, Afghanistan, and even as far away as China and Japan.** e.g. <https://m.youtube.com/watch?v=AV113IHQ-jw> and The Quest for the Lost Tribes Youtube documentary
- **In 1650 a former rabbi in Amsterdam dedicated a book called 'The Hope of Israel' to the British Parliament citing the 'lost tribes' came to Britain**
- **Richard Brothers in 1794, a self-declared prophet to the lost tribes**



further developed the idea of an Anglo-Israel (British Israel).

The Tribes are Scattered but not Lost

With some Jews dispersed and others intermarrying, the ten tribes were considered “lost” or “diluted” to history. But while the events are actual, the idea of any lost tribes is based strictly on assumptions and old Jewish traditions. None of it is biblical. The truth is God knows exactly where they are, and the Scriptures clearly reveal the evidence.

The prophet Isaiah prophesied the day God calls the tribes to Himself.

*“So it shall be in that day: The great trumpet will be blown. They will come, who are about to perish in the land of Assyria, and they who are outcasts in the land of Egypt and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem.” **Isaiah 27:13** 📖 NKJ*

Deuteronomy 30:3-6

⁴ If any of thine be driven out unto the outmost parts of heaven, from thence will the LORD thy God gather thee, and from thence will he fetch thee:

⁵ And the LORD thy God will bring thee into the land which thy fathers possessed, and thou shalt possess it; and he will do thee good, and multiply thee above thy fathers.

¹⁴ For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.

The Christian Israelite View

- The “lost” or “scattered” tribes could be anywhere in the world.
- Perhaps there might be DNA markers that link a person back to their historical tribe.
- Most importantly the call to follow God is from the heart to obey Him and keep his commandments.

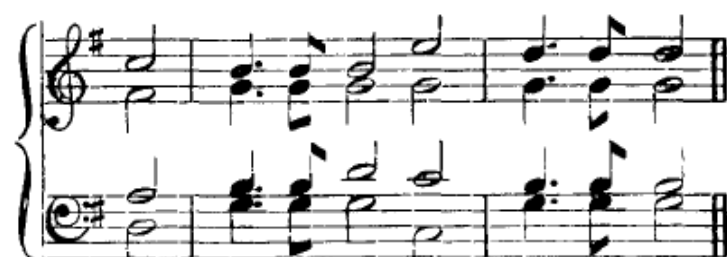
