

God's Love and Grace

What is Love?

- Love can be a challenge to define at the level of how a person experiences it.
- Love can involve personal affection, sexual attraction, platonic admiration, brotherly loyalty, benevolent concern, or worshipful adoration.
- To accurately answer the question "what is love?" we need to go to the origin of love. The Bible tells us that love originates in God.

Different Kinds of Love

Hebrew and Greek, are more precise in that they utilize different words for the different types of love. The ancient languages differentiate among sexual, brotherly, and familial love, and also the kind of love that God has for creation and that we may have for Him.

- Eros (Greek) and Yada (Hebrew) means sexual love.
- **Phileo** (Greek) and **Ahabah** (Hebrew) means brotherly love.
- Storge (Greek) or Ahabah (Hebrew) means family or tribal love.
- **Agape** (Greek) or **Chesed** (Hebrew) means the kind of love God demonstrates toward us.
 - It is also the goodwill and benevolence of God shown in self-sacrifice and an unconditional commitment to the loved one.

What is Grace?

Grace is the basis for the Christian faith.

- We believe we are saved by faith through grace.
- God's grace is usually defined as undeserved favor.
- Grace cannot be earned; it is something that is freely given.
- We count on God's grace and the bridge he built in our relationship with him.



In daily life it is sometimes hard to feel God's love and/or grace. It is also hard to make sense of suffering in terms of God's love and grace but the poem above gives us a different perspective to view it from.

Following are some Bible passages that further develop this theme. Remember it was man's choice to learn about God's love and grace from the viewpoint of good and evil, rather than just good.

In the story of Job we see Satan at work 'trying' Job's love for God.

Job 1:6-12

⁶ Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them.

⁷ And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.

⁸ And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?

⁹ Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought?

¹⁰ Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land.

¹¹ But put forth thine hand now, and touch all that he hath, and he will curse thee to thy face.

¹² And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, all that he hath is in thy

power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the LORD.

As you know Job experienced loss and disease together with a lot of bad advice from his friends. God's answer indicates that there is much more at stake than Job could possibly understand right now. In fact it seems it might even extend back to things that happened in our spiritual pre-existence.

Job 38:1-8

38 Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

- ² Who is this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge?
- ³ Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me.
- ⁴ Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- ⁵ Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it?
- ⁶ Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof;

- When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?
- ⁸ Or who shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, as if it had issued out of the womb?

James points out that temptation and suffering are not God's doing but should be used to grow our faith and our patience. Putting our faith into action is what perfects it.

James 1:2-4,12-15 & 2:20-22

² My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;

- ³ Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.
- ⁴ But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing....
- ¹² Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.
- ¹³ Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

- ¹⁴ But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
- ¹⁵ Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death...
- ^{2:20} But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?
- ²¹ Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? ²² Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect?

Jeremiah used the metaphor of a potter making vessels to describe the way God works in our lives, while in John Jesus used the metaphor of a gardener pruning back the growth on a grape vine so it could produce maximum fruit.

Jeremiah 18:1-6

18 The word which came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying,

⁴ And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it.

⁵ Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying,

⁶ O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand, O house of Israel.

Romans 9:21

Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

² Arise, and go down to the potter's house, and there I will cause thee to hear my words.

³ Then I went down to the potter's house, and, behold, he wrought a work on the wheels.

John 15

2 Corinthians 5:17-21

- Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- ¹⁸ And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;
- ¹⁹ To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself,

not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

²⁰ Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

²¹ For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

2 Peter 1:1-9

1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the

righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

² Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

³ According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

⁴ Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

- ⁵ And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;
- ⁶ And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;
- ⁷ And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
- ⁸ For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- ⁹ But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off,

and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

Romans 4:3-5
