- If it was the Apostle John, perhaps he was exiled because he was **not able to be killed**?
- Written when there was great persecution of Christians by the emperor Domitian – estimated between AD 81–96
- Exiling for political opponents was common

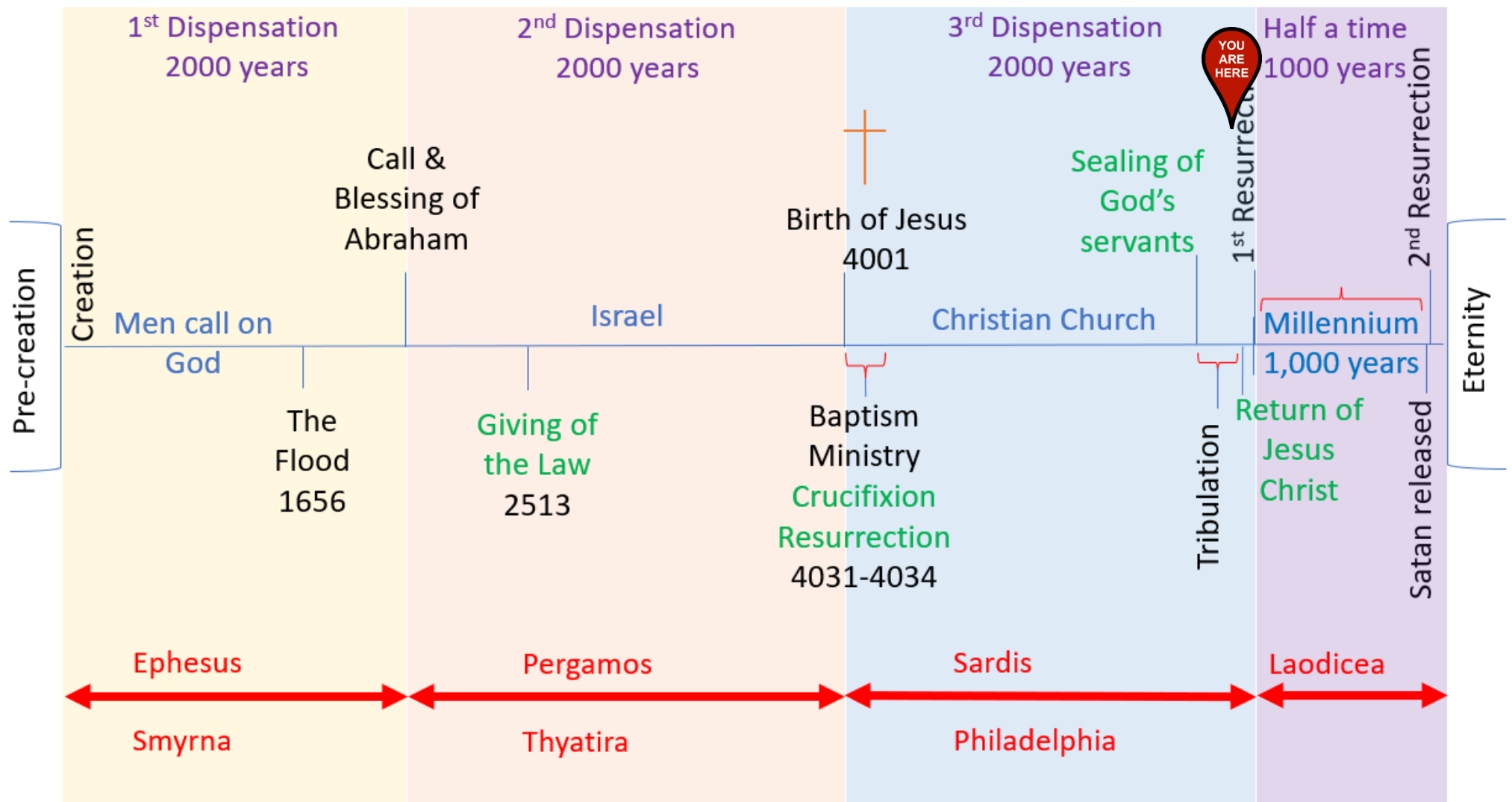
²¹ Peter seeing him saith to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do?

The Seven Angels

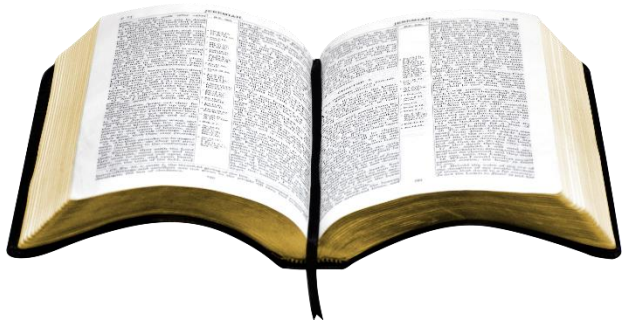

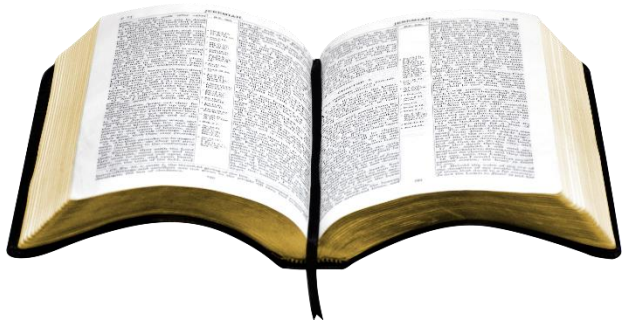

⁷ And **one of the four beasts** gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, **who liveth for ever and ever**.

Lion – Royalty, Dignity, Courage

Calf – Bears the burden, Sacrificed, Duty

Man – The image of God, Wisdom, Discernment, Love

Eagle – Sees all things, Transcends earthly things
