Many Christians are taught about this theory in school, and are forced to mush it into Christianity. As the billions of years are put in, the 7 days are kicked out!

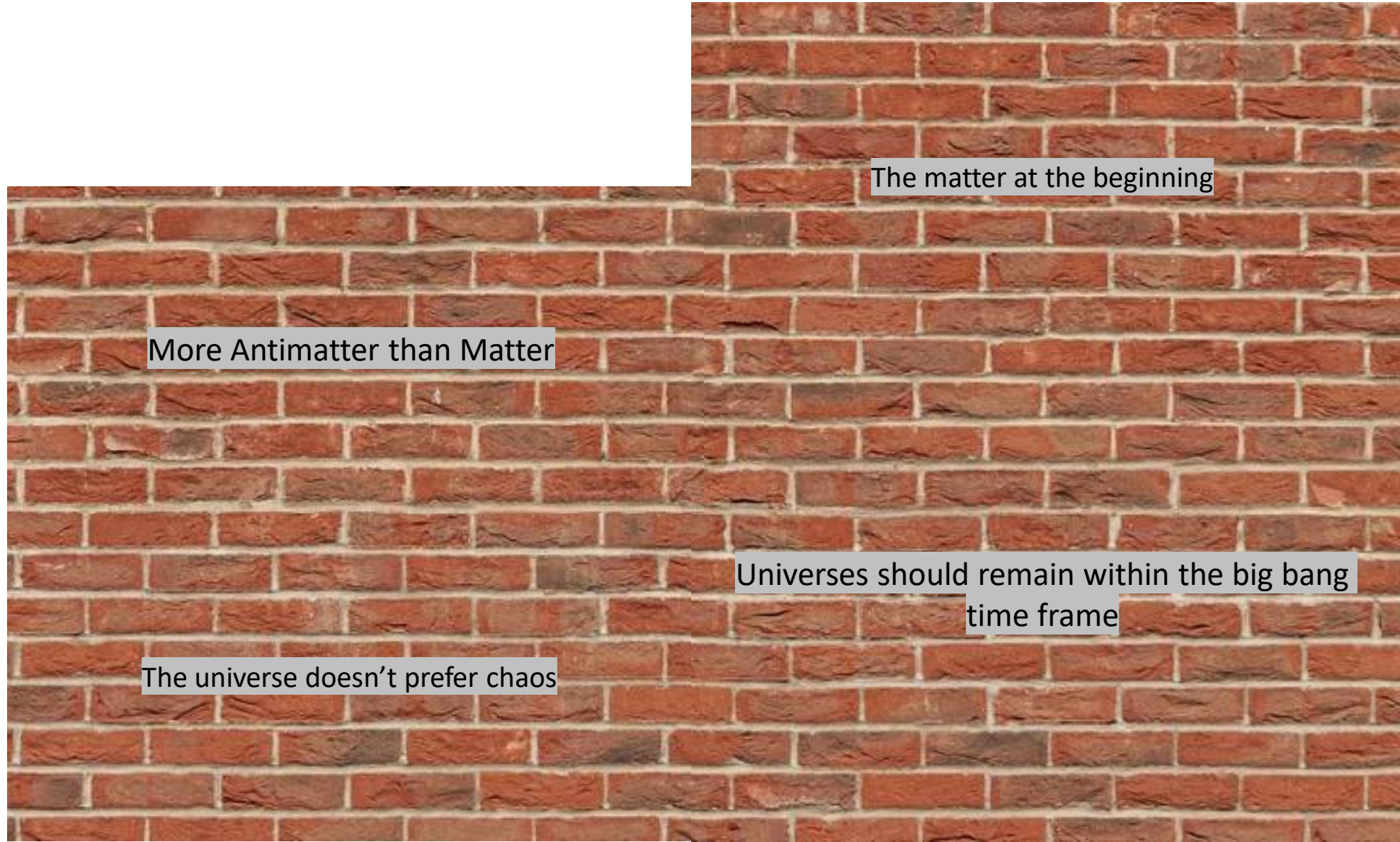
Okay than, we've established why Christians don't accept the creation story as literal. So lets see if this theory of big bang and evolution checks out scientifically!

Big Bang

Here are some of the foundational blocks for the big bang to work according to science.

According to the theory of the big bang, there should be more Antimatter than matter, but the fact is, we have found almost no antimatter. There should be whole galaxies of antimatter according to the big bang but we have barely even found any.

The second law of thermodynamics (in short) says that everything prefers chaos. The chance of the universe getting together and producing such order as the universe, stars, planets, life and animals is scientifically impossible

Every physical thing has a beginning, the matter said to have produced the big bang needed a beginning too, and none is provided with that theory. Some have made supernatural theories such as the multiverse and the looping universe, but these require as much faith as the Christian view (if not more) and are not backed by anything, unlike the bible.

The Hubble Telescope has discovered several galaxies that “should not exist”. Due to their redshift, these galaxies are dated to be made hundreds of millions of years after the big bang but they appear to be just as developed as the ones made at the big bang 500 million years earlier, which makes no sense and has left scientists confused.

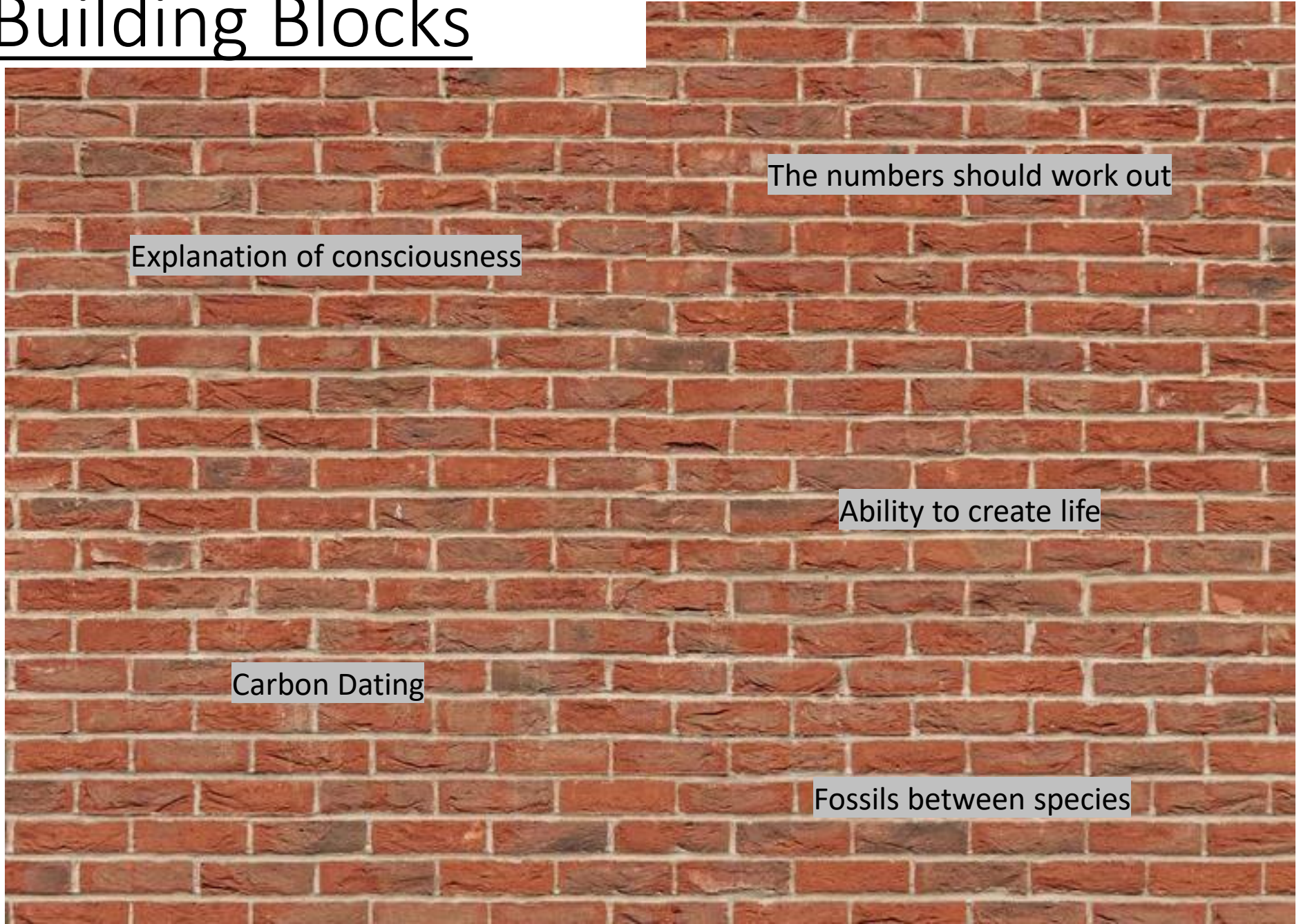

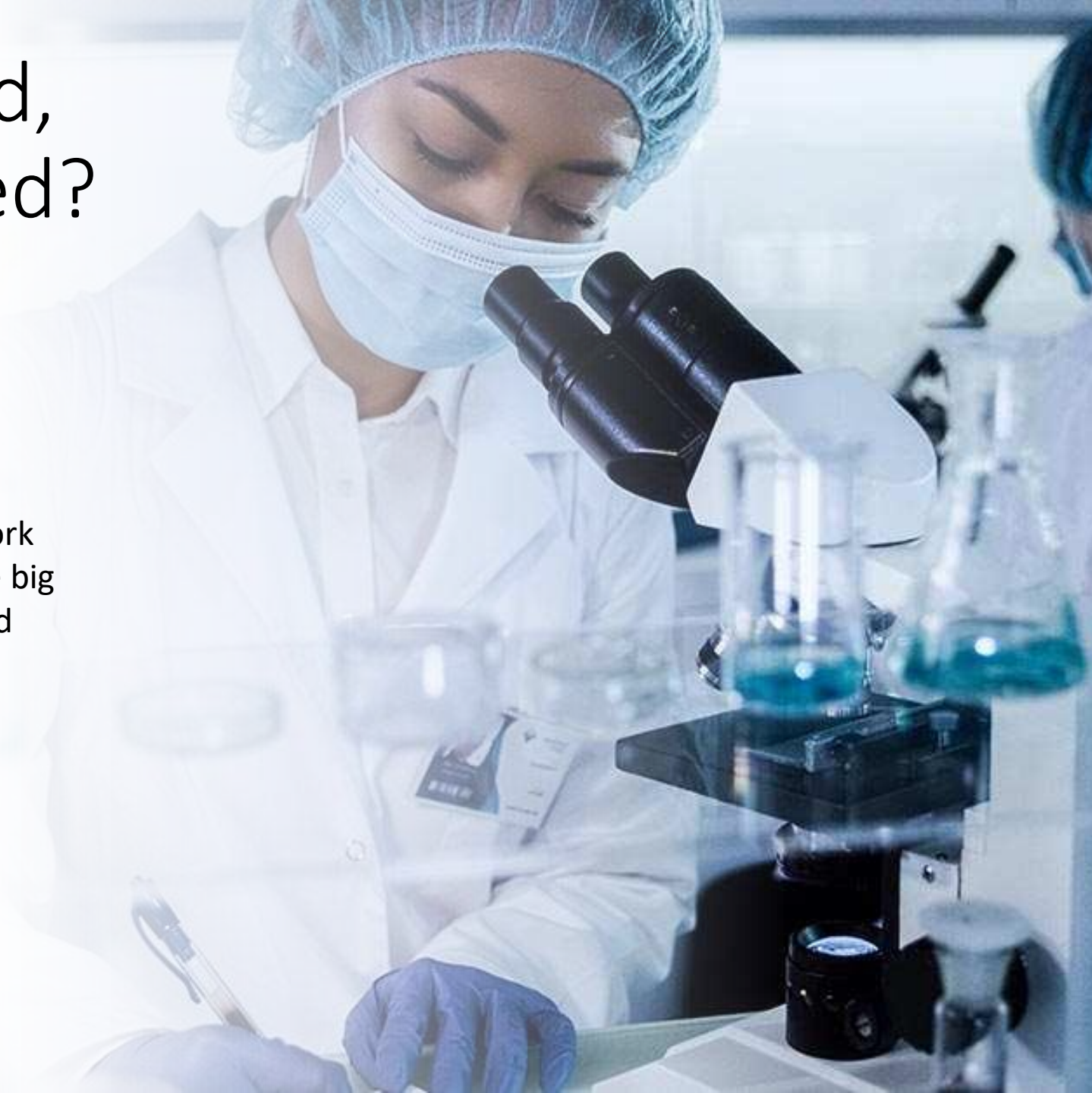


If evolution is so flawed, why is it widely believed?

Evolution and the big bang are widely believed, not because they are very factual or scientific, but because it is an alternative to God.

Scientists have spent billions of dollars and years of work searching for ways to fix the holes in evolution and the big bang that I have mentioned before, but have just found more questions...

Majority of modern science is shaped around the big bang and evolution, which is why the idea of a literal 7 day creation is so frowned upon.



A band aid God

Many modern Christians still do not reject the idea of the big bang and evolution, primarily because they may either believe it is strongly scientific or because it is a common belief and its much easier to go with the flow. As I covered earlier, evolution is full of holes so they adopt this term of band aid God, a God who made evolution and patched all its holes.



- While it is true that God could fix all these holes in the big bang and evolution, it doesn't make sense! Why would God bother to create the world in such a flawed way? Especially considering he already wrote down an alternative in Genesis, the 7 day creation.
- When God created the Earth, he said it was good. If we turn the 7 days of creation into a metaphor or we stretch them out into billions of years, we cannot call them good. Evolution relies on natural selection, which is the killing of animals to find out which ones survive and which ones don't. Before the first humans sinned (Adam and Eve), the world was perfect and no creature killed another according to the bible. So this doesn't make any sense!
- The idea of a band aid God also begs the question, at what point did apes become human enough to begin Gods plan for the world, and at what point can we take the bible seriously? If the start is a metaphor, why not the whole thing?

A few more common questions

There was no sun before day 4, so therefore how can the first 4 days be days?

- All that needs to be present for a day is a rotating planet and a light source, both of which were created before the end of day one.

There are parables and stories throughout the bible, why wouldn't this be one of them?

- Jesus's parable and other stories all serve a meaning or a purpose. Usually this is a moral or message. If the creation story was metaphorical, it would have a moral or message, which it doesn't.
- In fact, the non metaphorical creation story is a teaching of how we should live our week, having 6 days of work and one day of rest.

The Bible doesn't say how old the Earth is, which means it could be made over billions of years.

- While it doesn't give us any straight numbers, it does list the generations all the way down from Jesus to Adam, which if we do the math's, calculates to slightly less than 4000 years.
