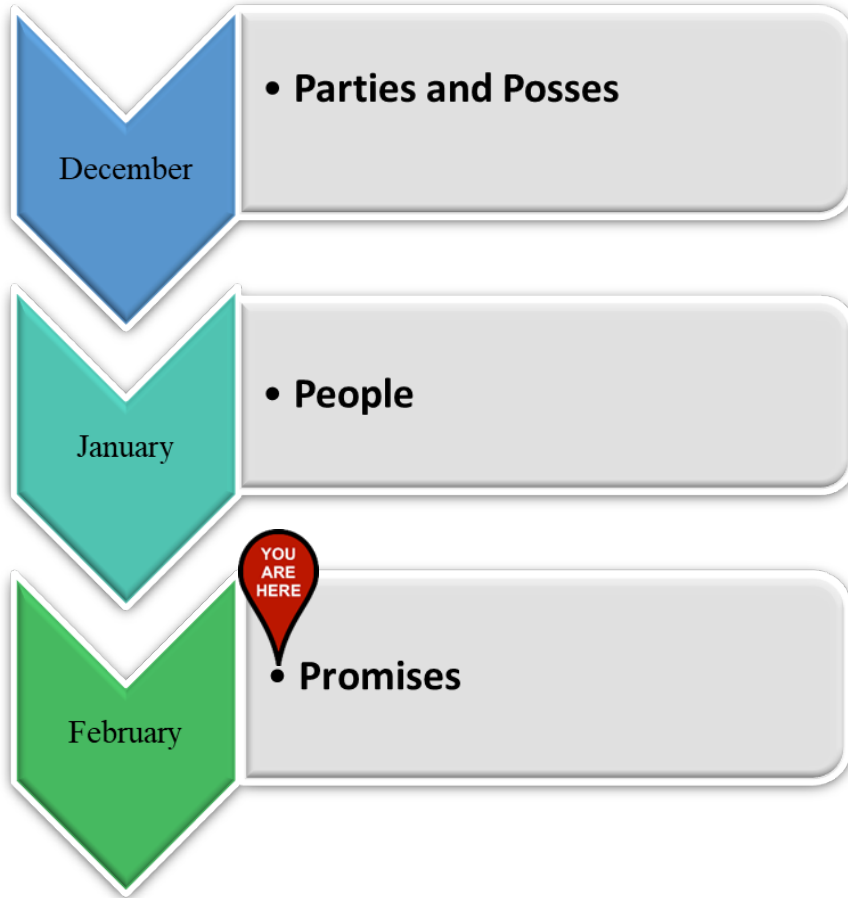

Why do we need to be pardoned?

Pardon	- to forgive or excuse
Sin	- disobedience to the law of God
Reconciliation	- to change from enmity to friendship, to reconcile
Forgive	- to pardon an offender / stop feeling angry or resentful towards (someone) for an offence, flaw, or mistake.
Justice	- rendering to everyone that which is his due / the quality of being just, impartial, or fair
Grace	- the free and undeserved favour of God, as manifested in the salvation of sinners and the bestowal of blessings.
Mercy	- compassion, kindness, pity or forgiveness (shown towards someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm)
Redeem	- gain or regain possession of (something) in exchange for payment / compensate for the faults of
Salvation	- preservation or deliverance from harm, ruin, or loss / deliverance from sin and its consequences, brought about by faith in Christ.

Salvation is God's way of redeeming people to himself by mercy and grace but also justice at the same time, by taking upon himself the punishment that we deserved through Jesus on the cross.

The first step to accepting a saviour is being able to recognise the need for a saviour

Jeremiah 50:17-20

18 Therefore thus saith the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.

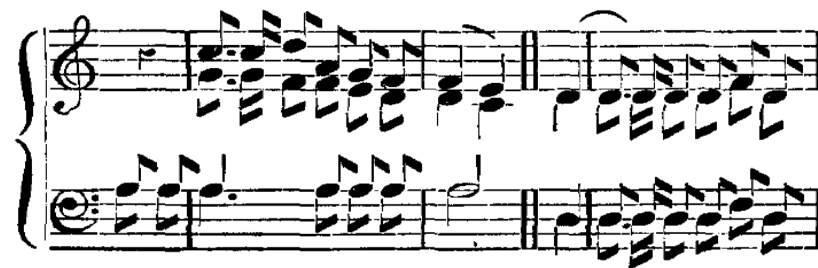
