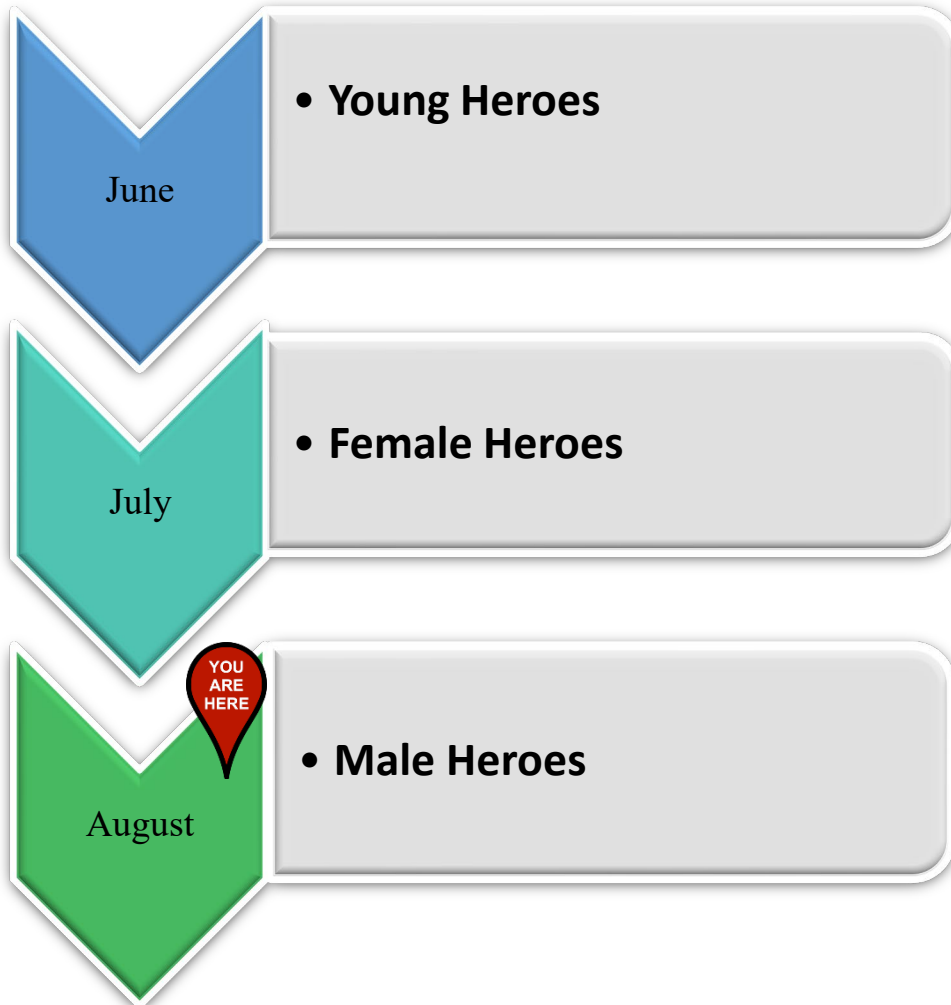

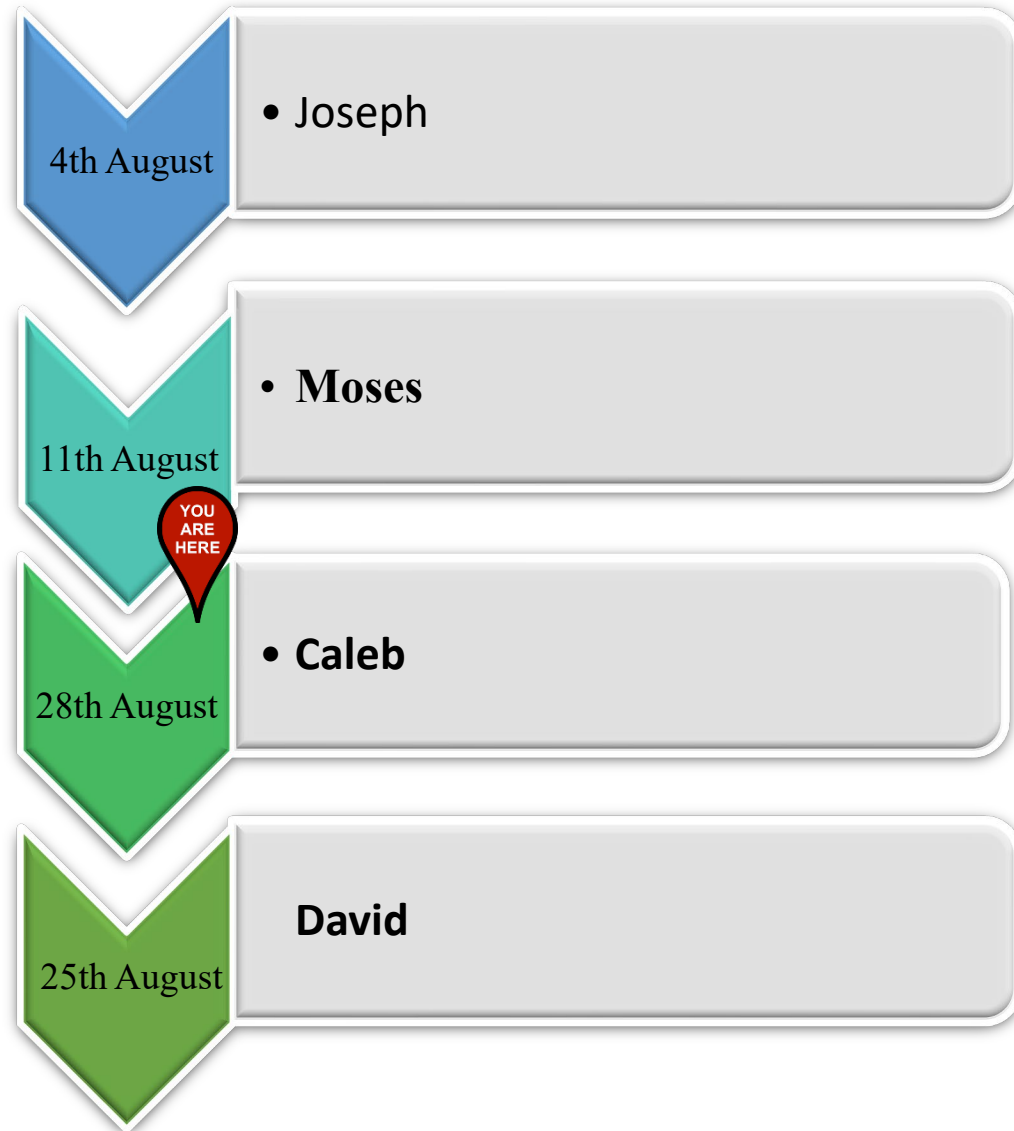

The Faithful and Favored



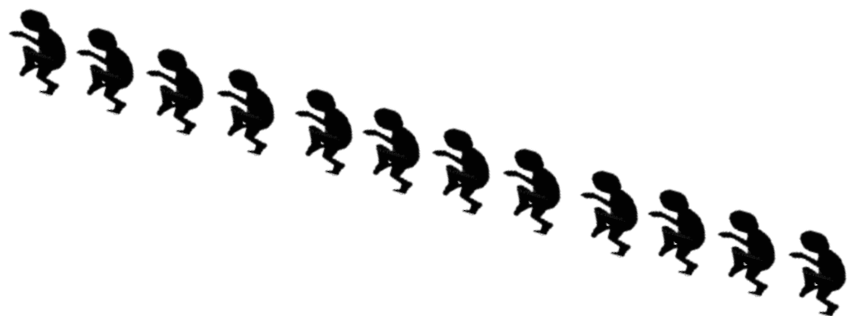
## Spy Profile:

**Name:** Caleb (Hebrew: כָּלֵב, Kalev)

**Tribe:** Tribe of Judah – Leader of the Tribe

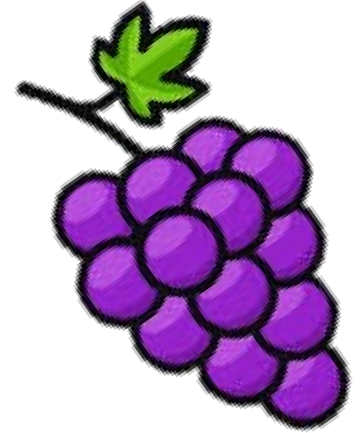
**Lineage:** Son of Jephunneh, who was a Kenizzite – No mention of Mother.

**Role:** One of the twelve spies sent by Moses to explore the land of Canaan.

## Mission Report:

The spies brought back fruits of great abundance from the promised land. Unlike the other ten spies, Caleb and Joshua gave a positive report about the land, encouraging the Israelites to proceed with the conquest (Num. 13:30; 14:6-9). However, the people were scared, even though God had promised that they would be victorious and possess this land.

## Faithful and Favored

**Faithfulness:** Caleb's trust in God's promises was unwavering. Despite pressure from the people and the negative reports from the other spies, Caleb remained confident that God would deliver the land to Israel (Numbers 14:24) because God had said it would be so.

**Favour:** Due to his faithfulness, Caleb was rewarded by God. He was one of only two (Joshua) original spies and of any in that generation of Israel permitted to enter the Promised Land (Numbers 14:30). And at 85 years old, Caleb was granted the city of Hebron as his inheritance, a significant and historic city in the land of Canaan (Joshua 14:6-15; 15:13-14).

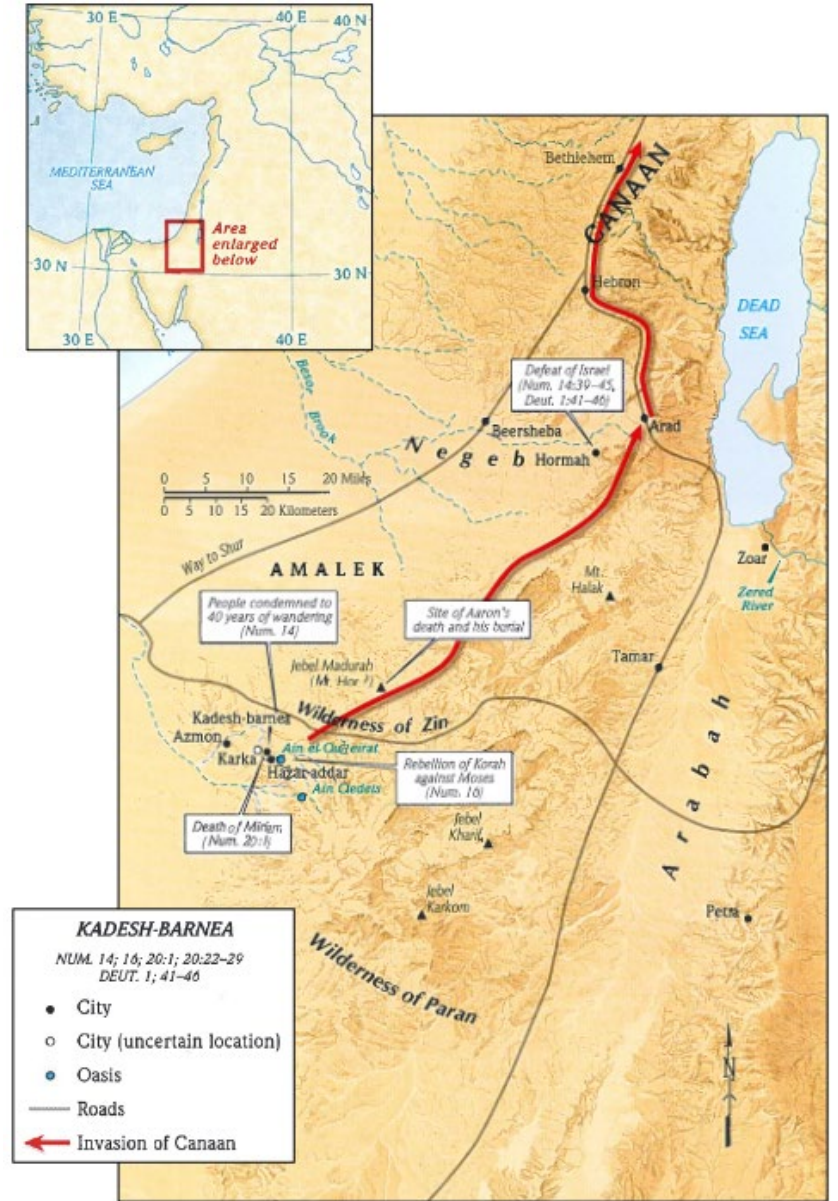

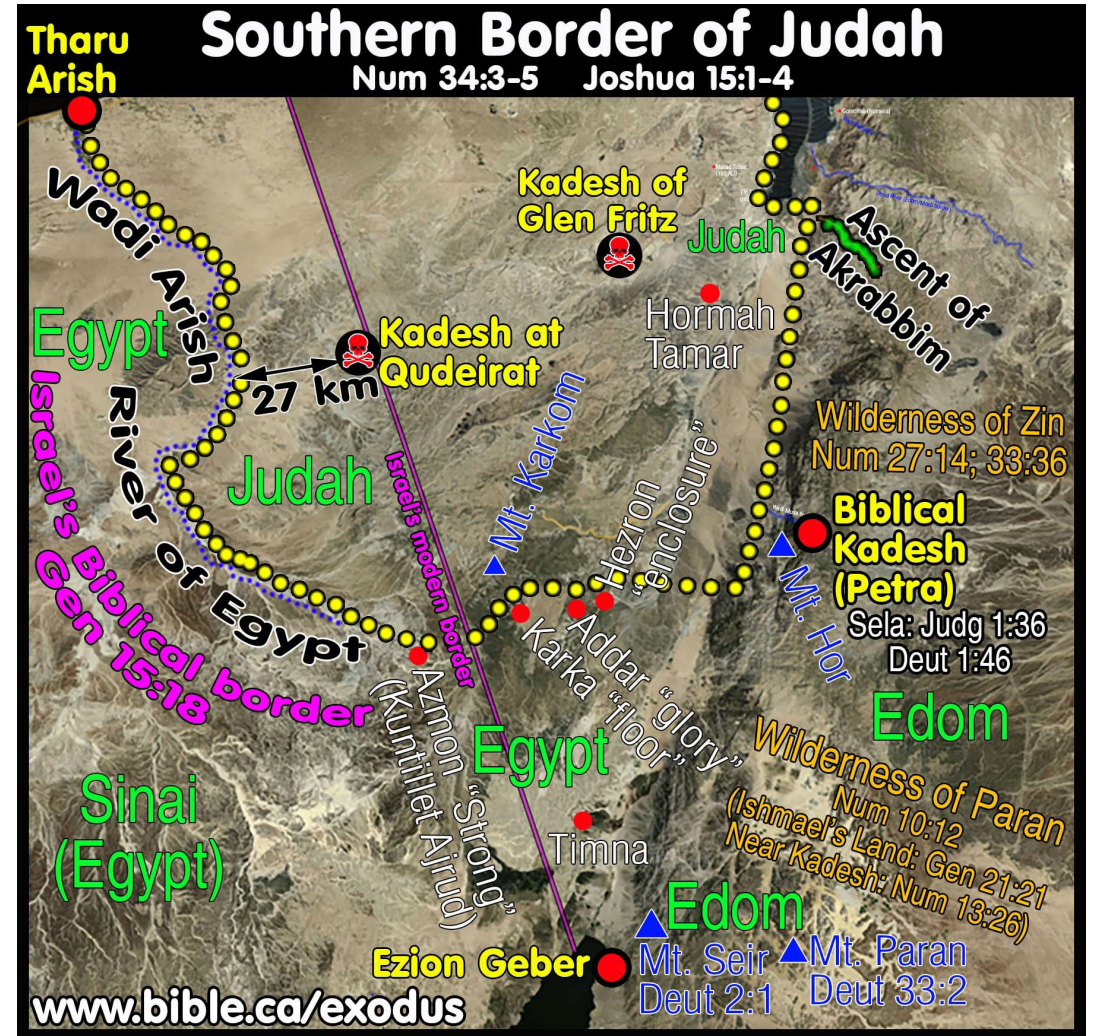

# Numbers 13

## *Men to search the land of Canaan*

[1] And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

[2] Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall ye send a man, every one a ruler among them.

[3] And Moses by the commandment of the LORD sent them from the wilderness of Paran: all those men were heads of the children of Israel.

[4] And these were their names: **of the tribe of Reuben, Shammua the son of Zaccur.**

[5] **Of the tribe of Simeon, Shaphat the son of Hori.**

[6] Of the tribe of Judah, Caleb the son of Jephunneh.

[7] **Of the tribe of Issachar, Igal the son of Joseph.**

[8] Of the tribe of Ephraim, Oshea the son of

Nun.

[9] Of the tribe of Benjamin, Palti the son of Raphu.

[10] Of the tribe of Zebulun, Gaddiel the son of Sodi.

[11] Of the tribe of Joseph, namely, of the tribe of Manasseh, Gaddi the son of Susi.

[12] Of the tribe of Dan, Ammiel the son of Gemalli.

[13] Of the tribe of Asher, Sethur the son of Michael.

[14] Of the tribe of Naphtali, Nahbi the son of Vophsi.

[15] Of the tribe of Gad, Geuel the son of Machi.

[16] These are the names of the men which Moses sent to spy out the land. And Moses called Oshea the son of Nun Jehoshua.

## *Your mission*

[17] And Moses sent them to spy out the land of Canaan, and said unto them, Get you up this way southward, and go up into the mountain:

[18] And see the land, what it is; and the people that dwelleth therein, whether they be strong or weak, few or many;

[19] And what the land is that they dwell in, whether it be good or bad; and what cities they be that they dwell in, whether in tents, or in strong holds;

[20] And what the land is, whether it be fat or lean, whether there be wood therein, or not. And be ye of good courage, and bring of the fruit of the land. Now the time was the time of the firstripe grapes.

### *The spies depart*

[21] So they went up, and searched the land from the wilderness of Zin unto Rehob, as men come to Hamath.

[22] And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmi, the children of Anak, were. (Now

Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.)

### Clarke's Commentary

Verse Numbers 13:22. *Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.* — The *Zoan* of the Scriptures is allowed to be the *Tanis* of the heathen historians, which was the capital of Lower Egypt. **Some think it was to humble the pride of the Egyptians, who boasted the highest antiquity,** that this note concerning the higher antiquity of Hebron was introduced by Moses. Some have supposed that it is more likely to have been originally a *marginal note*, which in process of time crept into the text; but all the versions and all the MSS. that have as yet been collated, acknowledge it.

[23] And they came unto the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from thence a branch with one



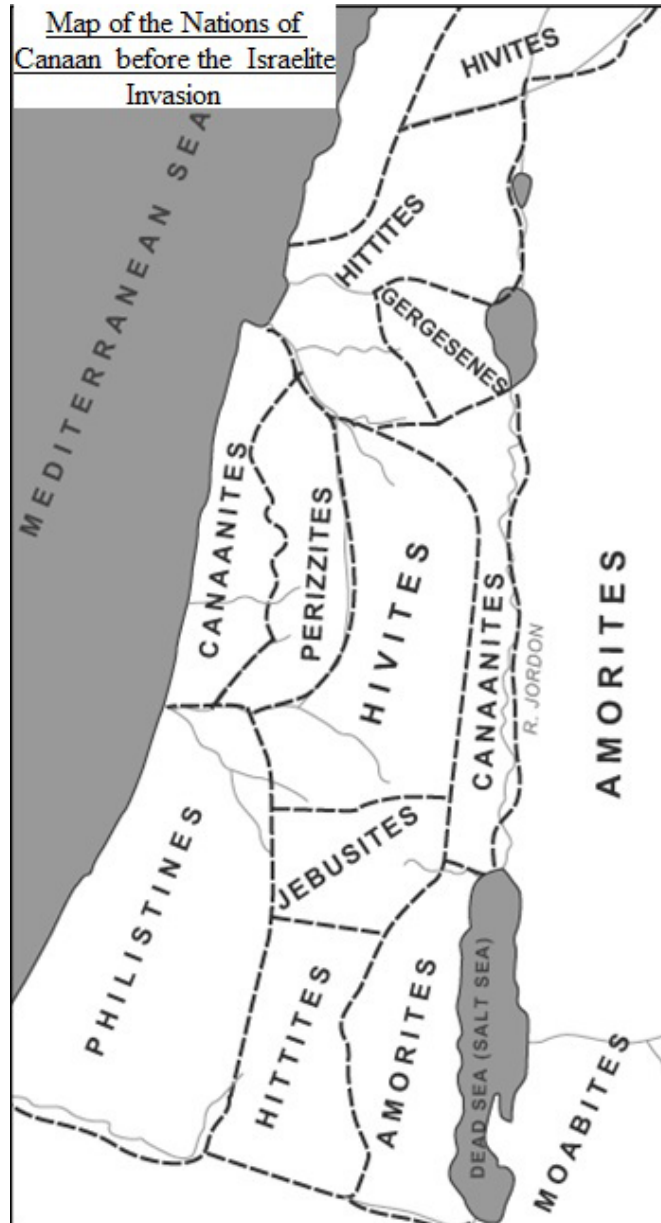
cluster of grapes, and they bare it between two upon a staff; and they brought of the pomegranates, and of the figs.

[24] The place was called the brook Eshcol, because of the cluster of grapes which the children of Israel cut down from thence.

### *An evil report*

[25] And they returned from searching of the land after forty days.

[26] And they went and came to Moses, and to Aaron, and to all the congregation of the children of Israel, unto the wilderness of Paran, to Kadesh; and brought back word



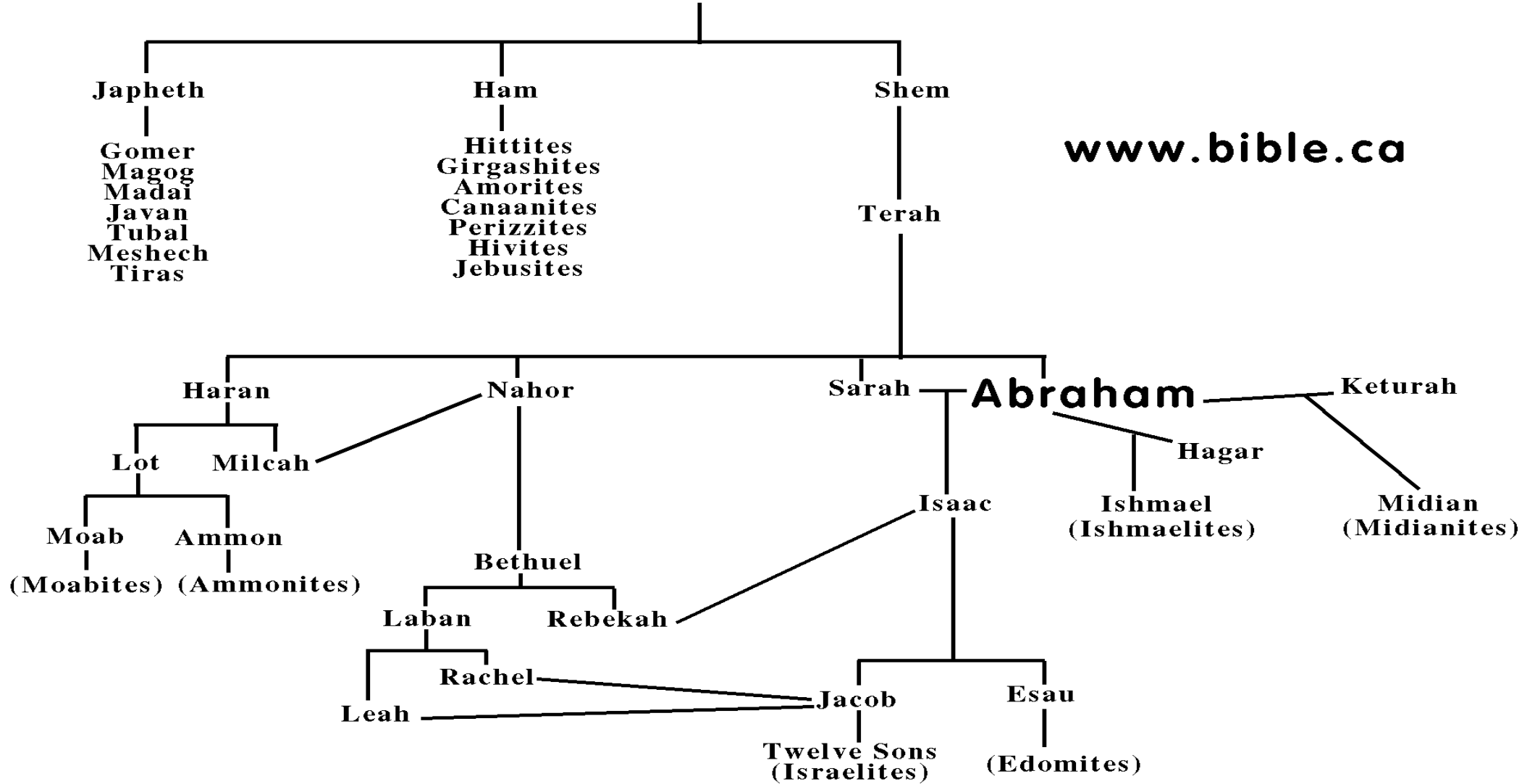
unto them, and unto all the congregation, and shewed them the fruit of the land.

[27] And they told him, and said, We came unto the land whither thou sentest us, and surely it floweth with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it.

[28] Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: and moreover we saw the children of Anak there.

[29] The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: and the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.

[30] And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it.

[31] But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we.

[32] And they brought up an evil report of the land which they had searched unto the children of Israel, saying, The land, through which we have gone to search it, is a land that eateth up the inhabitants thereof; and all the people that we saw in it are men of a great stature.

[33] And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

## Numbers 14

*Rebellion.... Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt*

[5] Then Moses and Aaron fell on their faces before all the assembly of the congregation of the children of Israel.

*The response of Joshua and Caleb*

[6] And Joshua the son of Nun, and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, which were of them that searched the land, rent their clothes:

[7] And they spake unto all the company of the children of Israel, saying, The land, which we passed through to search it, is an exceeding good land.

[8] If the LORD delight in us, then he will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land which floweth with milk and honey.

[9] Only rebel not ye against the LORD, neither fear ye the people of the land; for they are bread for us: their defence is departed from them, and the LORD is with us: fear them not.

### *Moses pleads for the people*

[20] And the LORD said, I have pardoned according to thy word:

[21] But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD.

[22] Because all those men which have seen my glory, and my miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice;

### *Provoked the Lord 10 times*

[23] Surely they shall not see the land which I swear unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it:

[24] But my servant Caleb, because he had another spirit with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it.

John 14:[16] And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

[17] Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

[18] I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

## Hebrews 3

*harden not your hearts, as in the provocation*

[7] Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice,

[8] Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:

[9] When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years.

[10] Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways.

[11] So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.)

[12] Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of

you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.

[13] But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

[14] For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

[15] While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, **harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.**

[16] For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

[17] But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness?



*they could not enter in because of unbelief*

[18] And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not?

[19] So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

## Mark 9

*all things are possible to him that believeth*

[22] ... if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.

[23] Jesus said unto him, **If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.**

[24] And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, **I believe; help thou mine unbelief.**
