



Cana is mentioned 3 times in the Bible



- It was the scene of Jesus' earliest miracle where he turned water into wine at a marriage feast John 2:1.
- It was the home of Nathaniel John 21:12.
- Jesus later returned to Cana and healed a nobleman's son remotely in Capernaum John 4:46,51.


Cana is located

- in Galilee, and
- in the uplands West of the lake.
- Its name in old Hebrew ganah means "place of reeds."

There are 2 or 3 other places Cana could be located but it appears it has

fallen into a degree of obscurity.

This ancient name survives in Khirbet Qana, a ruined site with rockhewn tombs, cisterns and a pool, on the northern edge of Sahl el-Battauf, the plain of Asochis. Near by are marshy stretches where reeds still abound: the name therefore is entirely appropriate. The name Qana el-Jelil, the exact Arabic equivalent of Kana tes Galilaias, is also heard among the natives.



The Wedding Feast - Cultural Context

• Weddings as covenantal symbols:

Jewish weddings weren't just social events—they echoed **God's covenant with Israel**. Jesus performing His first miracle at a wedding hints at the **new covenant** He's initiating.

Purification jars:

The six stone jars used were for ritual cleansing. By transforming water in these jars into wine, Jesus redefines **purity**—not through ritual, but through **grace and transformation**.

Hospitality norms:

Running out of wine was a serious breach of hospitality. Jesus' intervention restores honor and joy, reflecting His role as the **bridegroom of the Church** who provides abundantly.


Use of Stone Water Pots

The Gospel of John records that there were six stone water jars

containing two or three measures each

- These stone jars are often referred to (in Aramaic) as a krater or a *kalal*,
- These large jars were usually about 65 to 80 cm high and 40 to 50 cm in diameter, containing 2 to 3 *metretas*, or about 34 liters



- The craftsmanship varied from functional to ornate,
- There was an industry for producing stone vessels during this period centered at Jerusalem.

Stone Water Pots as Symbols

Stone vessels were common in Judea for ritual cleansing purposes

- according to the Law of Moses stone would not become impure, unlike the pottery of ancient times (Leviticus 6:28, 11:33-36).

Leviticus 6:28 But the earthen vessel wherein it is sodden shall be broken: and if it be sodden in a brasen pot, it shall be both scoured, and rinsed in water.

Running water or "living water" was considered ritually pure, and water collected in a stone cistern could be used later for purification purposes (Leviticus 11:36, 15:13).

Leviticus 11:36 Nevertheless a fountain or pit, wherein there is plenty of water, shall be clean: but that which toucheth their carcase shall be unclean.

The primary purpose of these washing rituals was to become spiritually clean or holy, rather than physically clean.

The Symbol of Wine as "Living Water"

Later in the Gospel of John, "living water" is mentioned multiple times.

- Jesus says eternal life that He gives is living water, and those that drink of it will never again thirst (John 4:10-15; cf. John 7:38).

John 4:10&14 ¹⁰ Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water...... ¹⁴ But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

Drinking wine from jars used for ritual purification would have sent a powerful message of spiritual purification to those in attendance at the wedding.

The miracle of turning water into wine authenticated Jesus as sent from God, and there may also be a connection between drinking the wine that Jesus gave them at the wedding and the wine that symbolizes the Spirit that reconciles us to God.

Stone Water Pots Represent our Lives/Bodies

Man's mortal body is as a pitcher, and if they die they are as a cracked pitcher (Ecclesiastes 12:6). But the pitchers must be whole, like those Jesus spoke of, "Fill the water-pots with water. And they filled them up to the brim" John 2:7. And that water which was made wine, is as the Spirit that fills them up DC2 6/10/1848

Ecclesiastes 12:1,5-7 ¹Remember now thy Creator in the days of thy youth, while the evil days come not, nor the years draw nigh, when thou shalt say, I have no pleasure in them.... because man goeth to his long home, and the mourners go about the streets: ⁶ Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern.

⁷Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

The Transformation of our Bodies/Water Pots

If the 6 water pots can represent the lives of mankind over the 6,000 years of the world's biblical history what message is contained in this story of the wedding at Cana?

Isaiah 28:16-18 ¹⁶ Therefore thus saith the Lord God, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste.

¹⁷ Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place.

¹⁸ And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it.

Transformation Completed

There are 2 transformations salvation and redemption

1 Corinthians 15:51-55 ⁵¹ Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, ⁵² In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

⁵³ For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

⁵⁴ So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

⁵⁵ O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

John 2:1-11 The Wedding in Cana

And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:

- ² And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.
- ³ And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine.
- ⁴ Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come.
- ⁵ His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.
- ⁶ And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.
- ⁷ Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.
- ⁸ And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.

- ⁹ When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,
- ¹⁰ And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.
- ¹¹ This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.
