

The Boss Move

- ⁷ So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- ⁸ And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.
- ⁹ And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.
- ¹⁰ When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?
- ¹¹ She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

"Boss move" typically refers to an action, decision, or behaviour that is assertive, confident, and effective, often in a professional or leadership context. It can also be used to describe a situation where someone takes control or demonstrates strong leadership qualities.

The Light of the World

¹² Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

- ¹⁴ Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

- ¹³ The Pharisees therefore said unto him, Thou bearest record of thyself; thy record is not true.
- ¹⁴ Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, yet my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.
- ¹⁵ Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man.
- ¹⁶ And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me.
- ¹⁷ It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true.
- ¹⁸ I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.
- ¹⁹ Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.

John 1:15

¹⁵ John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me.

- ³⁰ I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

²³ And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world.

²⁸ Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.

²⁹ And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

³⁰ As he spake these words, many believed on him.
