John 9

Jesus heals the blind man.

- [1] And as Jesus passed by, he saw a man which was blind from his birth.
- [2] And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?
- [3] Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- [4] I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- [5] As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.
- [6] When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,


Luke 13

- [1] There were present at that season some that told him of the Galilaeans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices.
- [2] And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose ye that these Galilaeans were sinners above all the Galilaeans, because they suffered such things?
- [3] I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
- [4] Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?
- [5] I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

Proverbs 3:[27] Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of thine hand to do it.


[7] And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

Isaiah 8

- [6] Forasmuch as this people refuseth the waters of Shiloah that go softly, and rejoice in Rezin and Remaliah's son;
- [7] Now therefore, behold, the Lord bringeth up upon them the waters of the river, strong and many, even the king of Assyria, and all his glory: and he shall come up over all his channels, and go over all his banks:
- [8] And he shall pass through Judah; he shall overflow and go over, he shall reach even to the neck; and the stretching out of his wings shall fill the breadth of thy land, O Immanuel.



- [8] The neighbours therefore, and they which before had seen him that he was blind, said, Is not this he that sat and begged?
- [9] Some said, This is he: others said, He is like him: but he said, I am he.
- [10] Therefore said they unto him, How were thine eyes opened?
- [11] He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.
- [12] Then said they unto him, Where is he? He said, I know not.
- [13] They brought to the Pharisees him that aforetime was blind.

Dispute about healing on the sabbath day.

[14] And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.

- [15] Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see.
- [16] Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. Others said, How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles? And there was a division among them.
- [17] They say unto the blind man again, What sayest thou of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? He said, He is a prophet.

The Jews did not believe him

- [18] But the Jews did not believe concerning him, that he had been blind, and received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight.
- [19] And they asked them, saying, Is this your son, who ye say was born blind? how then doth he now see?

- [20] His parents answered them and said, We know that this is our son, and that he was born blind:
- [21] But by what means he now seeth, we know not; or who hath opened his eyes, we know not: he is of age; ask him: he shall speak for himself.
- [22] These words spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue.
- [23] Therefore said his parents, He is of age; ask him.
- [24] Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: we know that this man is a sinner.
- [25] He answered and said, Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.
- [26] Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?

- [27] He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear it again? will ye also be his disciples?
- [28] Then they reviled him, and said, Thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples.
 [29] We know that God spake unto Moses: as for this fellow, we know not from whence he is.

The blind man responds

[30] The man answered and said unto them, Why herein is a marvellous thing, that ye know not from whence he is, and yet he hath opened mine eyes.

[31] Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

[32] Since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind.

[33] If this man were not of God, he could do nothing.

Matthew 10

[18] And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.
[19] But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.

[34] They answered and said unto him, Thou wast altogether born in sins, and dost thou teach us? And they cast him out.

Psalm 51

[5] Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.

Jesus reveals himslef to the man.

[35] Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the Son of God?

[36] He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might believe on him?

[37] And Jesus said unto him, Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee.

[38] And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.

[39] And Jesus said, For judgment I am

come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

- [40] And some of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also?
- [41] Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.

- [17] Behold, thou art called a Jew, and restest in the law, and makest thy boast of God, [18] And knowest his will, and approvest the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law;
- [19] And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness,
