

21st September

Colours in the Bible

Specific colours are mentioned – each colour is a component of the True Light.

28th September

New Jerusalem's Dimensions (Revelation 21:16)

- The city is described as:
 - 12,000 stadia in length, breadth, and height
 - That equals roughly 2,200 to 2,400 kilometers per side, depending on how one converts a stadion (typically ~185 meters)
- The area is over ½ the size of Australia and about twice the size of Pakistan and reaches upwards to the level of the lowest medium earth orbit satellites.
- The walls alone are 66m high (a 20 storey building)
- That's not just a city—it's a cosmic sanctuary, echoing the cubeshaped Holy of Holies in the Temple (1 Kings 6:20).
- The entire city is a holy place, saturated with God's presence.


Symbolism of the Numbers and City

- The Number 12,000
 - 12 is the number of divine government—12 tribes, 12 apostles.
 - 1,000 often symbolizes completeness or vastness in apocalyptic literature.
 - So 12 × 1,000 = 12,000 implies totality of divine order—a perfected, expansive kingdom.
- The Holy City
 - The cube shape suggests perfection, symmetry, and divine order
 - The vast scale implies abundant space for all redeemed humanity.

The Structure of the City

The foundations are made of precious stones.



- Foundations also imply principles or ways to live



The Tribes of Israel arranged around the Tabernacle



- Each Tribe had a special stone and standard.
- This same formation/ pattern is described in the gates into New Jerusalem in Revelation 21.
- The precious stones match fairly well considering O/T nomenclature was not standardized.
- The stones were in the High Priests breast plate.

The Effect of 'Pure' Light



- Gems can be classified as isotropic or anisotropic.
- When cross-polarised light is passed through anisotropic gems they light up with rainbow colours.
- Other more 'precious' gems are dull (below).
- Is that why these gems are chosen in Revelation?
- When God 'lights us up' we can become beautiful like these gems



Revelation 21:1-22

The New Jerusalem

- ¹And I saw a new heaven and a new earth.... And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.
- ⁵ And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. ... ⁶I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. ⁷ He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

- ¹⁰ And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, ¹¹ Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal; ¹² And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:
- ¹³ On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.
- ¹⁴ And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.
- ¹⁵ And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof.
- ¹⁶ And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

- ¹⁷ And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.
- ¹⁸ And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold, like unto clear glass.
- And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald; ²⁰ The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolyte; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.
- ²¹ And the twelve gates were twelve pearls: every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.
- ²² And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

Symbolic of The Fall of Satan

- ¹² Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GoD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty. ¹³ Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.
- ¹⁴ Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. ¹⁵ Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.
- ¹⁶ By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

- ¹⁷ Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

- ²⁴ Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field: ²⁵ But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way.
- ²⁶ But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then appeared the tares also. ²⁷ So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares?
- ²⁸ He said unto them, An enemy hath done this. The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up? ²⁹ But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them. ³⁰ Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

- ⁴⁴ Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field.
- ⁴⁵ Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls: ⁴⁶ Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it.
- ⁴⁷ Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a net, that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind: ⁴⁸ Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away.
