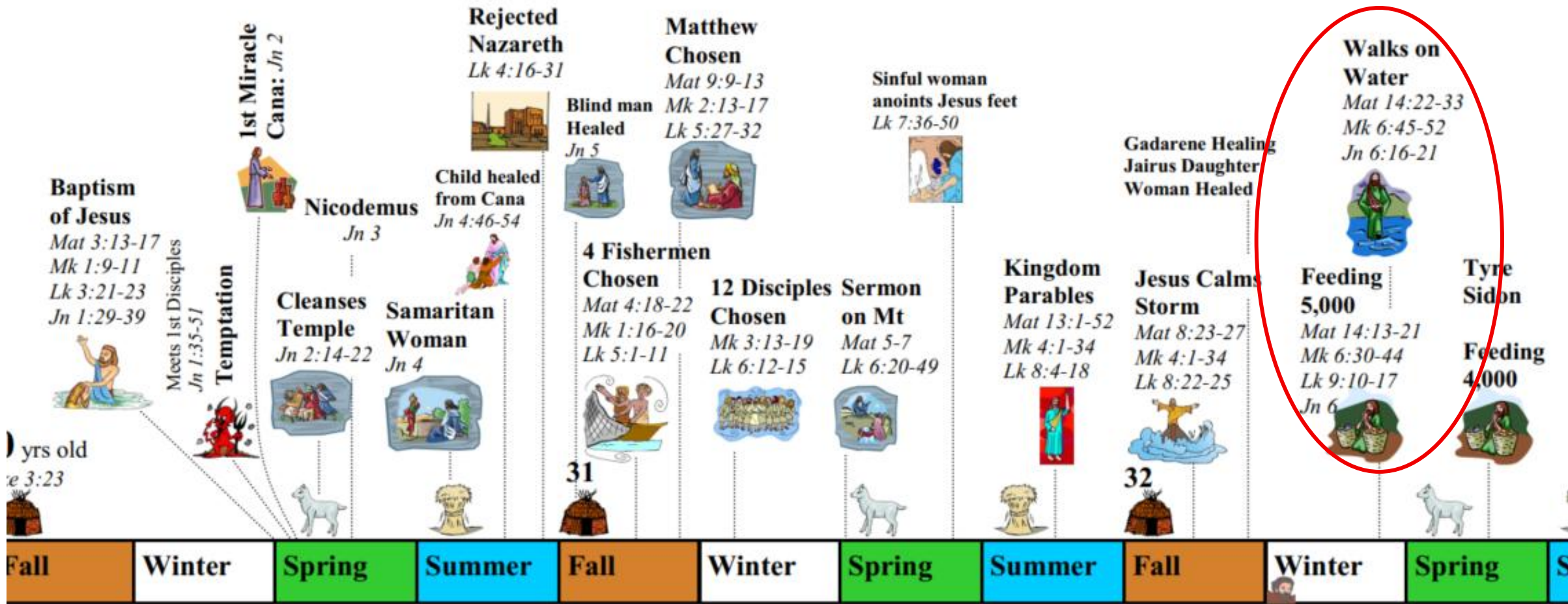

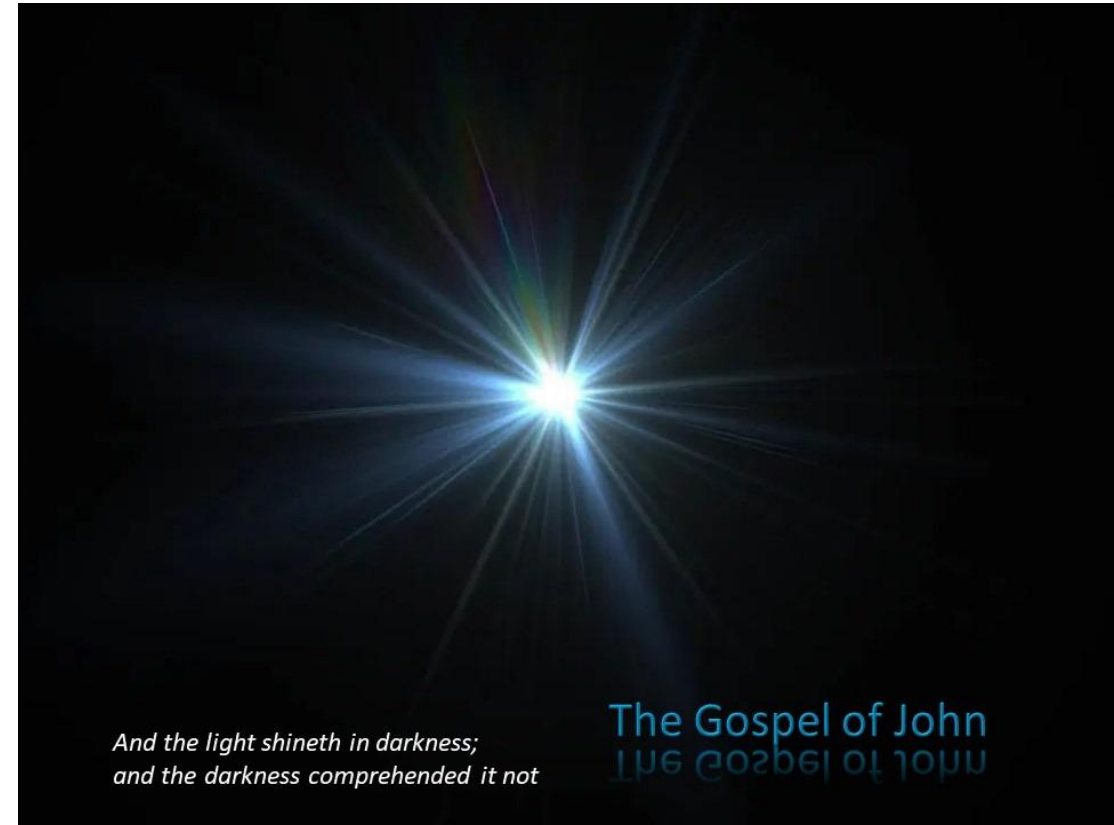

John Chapter 6

The Sign that Sets the Stage (John 6:1–14)

- Before Jesus speaks the deep words of John 6, He performs a sign.
 - A hungry multitude, Five loaves, Two fish
 - Jesus looks to heaven, blesses, breaks, multiplies, and feeds thousands until “*they were filled.*”
- This miracle pointed beyond bread -
It pointed to Himself.



*And the light shineth in darkness;
and the darkness comprehended it not*

John Chapter 6

Where are we now?

- The feeding of the 5000 took place in the region of Bethsaida, on the north-eastern side of the Sea of Galilee.
- Today's text is actually recorded as being on the day following this amazing miracle – back in Capernaum, in the Synagogue



John 6:24-58

Hungry for more...

²⁴ When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither his disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, seeking for Jesus.

²⁵ And when they had found him on the other side of the sea, they said unto him, Rabbi, when camest thou hither?

²⁶ Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.**

²⁷ **Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life,** which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.

The Natural man wants perishable bread.

The Poor in Spirit desires eternal bread.

-  The people were hungry for the miracle
-  Jesus corrects this desire for something better

Jesus steers the conversation

²⁸ Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?

²⁹ Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.

³⁰ They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work?

³¹ Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, **He gave them bread from heaven to eat.**

³² Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but **my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven.**

³³ **For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.**

³⁴ Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.



🍞 Manna sustained natural life.

🍞 Christ sustains spiritual life.

The Bread of Life

³⁵ And Jesus said unto them, **I am the bread of life**: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

³⁶ But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.

³⁷ All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

³⁸ **For I came down from heaven**, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.



³⁹ And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of **all which he hath given me** I should lose nothing, but **should raise it up** again at the last day.

⁴⁰ And this is the will of him that sent me, that **every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him**, may have everlasting life: and **I will raise him up** at the last day.

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

¹⁶ For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and **the dead in Christ shall rise** first:

¹⁷ Then **we which are alive and remain** shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

Unbelief Exposed

⁴¹ The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven.

⁴² And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? how is it then that he saith, I came down from heaven?

⁴³ Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves.

⁴⁴ No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

⁴⁵ It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.

⁴⁶ Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the Father.



The imagery goes deeper

⁴⁷ Verily, verily, I say unto you, **He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.**

⁴⁸ I am that bread of life.

⁴⁹ Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead.

⁵⁰ This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that **a man may eat thereof, and not die.**

⁵¹ I am the living bread which came down from heaven: **if any man eat of this bread**, he shall live for ever: **and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.**



⁵² The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, **How can this man give us his flesh to eat?**

Jesus doubles down

⁵³ Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.

⁵⁴ Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.

⁵⁵ For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

⁵⁶ He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

⁵⁷ As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: **so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.**

⁵⁸ This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

Breaking down what Jesus is saying

Eating the flesh and drinking the blood:

- 🔴 You have no life in you unless you do
- 🔴 You have eternal life if you do
- 🔴 You will be raised up at the last day if you do
- 🔴 If you do this, you dwell in him and he in you

Leviticus 18:5

⁵ Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: **which if a man do, he shall live in them:** I am the Lord.

Eating and Drinking

John 6:52

“How can this man give us his flesh to eat?”

They thought physically
Jesus is speaking spiritually.

John 6:29

²⁹ Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, **that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.**

Through belief (**drink**) in Jesus
and his sacrifice (**blood**),
we have salvation of our soul.

John 6:63

“It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.”

John 6:56

“He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.”

By obeying (**eating**)
his words (**bread**),
his flesh (**perfection**)
can change our body to be like his. (Romans 8:29)
