

Last week – Blood and the 'Bread of Life'

Shirley spoke about blood, how it came to be the source of life, and death, in our physical body.

Our life of blood must be replaced by the life of God's Spirit so we can live eternally.

This is our daily (spiritual) bread which we pray for.

1 Corinthians 15:50 - Change is Required

... flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

Romans 8:11 - Indwelling Spirit Changes Us

But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

The Law Against Eating Blood or Fat

 Leviticus 3:17 and Leviticus 17:10–14 forbid eating blood or certain fats.

Blood symbolized life, which belonged to God.

...Ye shall eat the blood of no manner of flesh: for the life of all flesh is the blood thereof... Leviticus 17:14

Chemistry of Blood: Life in Molecular Form

Biologically, blood is the literal carrier of life:

- Oxygen Transport: Red blood cells contain *hemoglobin*, a protein that binds oxygen and delivers it to tissues.
- Nutrient Delivery: Blood plasma carries glucose, amino acids, hormones, and electrolytes to nourish cells.
- **Immune Defense**: White blood cells patrol the bloodstream, fighting infections and repairing tissue.
- Waste Removal: Blood transports carbon dioxide and metabolic waste to organs for excretion.
- Clotting and Healing: Platelets and clotting factors prevent bleeding and initiate healing.

In essence, every function that sustains life is mediated through blood. The biblical statement "the life is in the blood" is not just poetic—it's biochemically accurate.

Food Laws in the Bible

The Bible contains a variety of **food laws**, mainly found in the **Old Testament**, particularly in **Leviticus**, **Deuteronomy**, and **Genesis**.

These laws cover what can be eaten, how food should be prepared, and the spiritual meaning behind dietary purity.

God said,

² For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth. ³ Thou shalt not eat any abominable thing.

Deuteronomy 14:2&3

Today we will look at what can be eaten

The Original Diet (Genesis)

God gives humans a plant-based diet for food.
 And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat. Genesis 1:29

After the Flood

 God allows Noah and his descendants to eat animals but forbids eating blood:

³ Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things. ⁴ But flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat. Genesis 9:3–4

The Food Laws Given to Moses

 These are the core of biblical dietary law, often called kashrut in Judaism.

The Law - Clean and Unclean Animals (Leviticus 11, Deuteronomy 14)

Land Animals:

- Clean: those that **chew the cud** and **have split hooves** (e.g., cattle, sheep, goats, deer).
- Unclean: animals missing one of these traits (e.g., pigs, camels, rabbits).

Sea Creatures:

- Clean: those with **fins and scales** (e.g., most fish).
- Unclean: all others (shellfish, eels, catfish, etc.).

Birds:

- Forbidden: birds of prey and scavengers (e.g., eagles, hawks, vultures, owls, ravens).
- Permitted: typically grain-eating or non-predatory birds (e.g., doves, pigeons, chickens).

Insects:

- Allowed: certain locusts, crickets, and grasshoppers.
- Forbidden: all other creeping insects.

The Purpose Behind the Dietary Laws

The distinction between clean and unclean animals serves several purposes.

- It emphasizes the concept of ritual purity and
- the separation of the sacred from the profane.
- Additionally, it may reflect health and hygiene considerations, as many unclean animals are known carriers of diseases.

This law also influenced later Christian and Islamic dietary traditions.

New Testament Perspectives

- Mark 7, Jesus taught that what defiles a man comes from within more than without shifting focus from ritual purity to inner morality.
 - There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can defile him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that defile the man., Mark 7:15
- Acts 10, records Peter's vision where a sheet of unclean animals symbolizes that the old dietary laws and the separation of Israel from the Gentile nations. Many take from this that the old food laws were no longer binding for Gentile believers.
- Romans 14, Paul says each person should eat according to conscience but not judge others

 ¹Him that is weak in the faith receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations.

 ² For one believeth that he may eat all things: another, who is weak, eateth herbs. Romans 14:1&2

The Jerusalem Council

The Jerusalem Council, convened to consider what matters of the law new Gentile converts should keep, still recommended avoiding:

- Food sacrificed to idols
- Sexual Immorality
- Strangled animals
- Blood

¹⁹ Wherefore my sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: ²⁰ But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.

Acts 15:20&21

This still preserved the moral essence of the old laws without the full ritual code. The old rules were about **holiness and separation**, not just hygiene, where food mirrored moral and spiritual boundaries.

A Few Health Reasons to Avoid Unclean Meats

Pigs

In his book The Genesis Diet, Dr. Gordon Tessler writes that "the indiscriminate eating patterns of omnivores like pigs make them disease carriers. Pigs are known to carry up to 200 diseases and 18 different parasites and worms, including the deadly [round] worm called trichinella spiralis.... Trichinosis [the disease caused by this particular worm] can mimic other diseases such as arthritis, rheumatism, or typhoid fever.... Perhaps many other diseases are misdiagnosed [when] their real cause is ... [the] many parasites found in the flesh of the unclean swine. A person may be committing slow suicide when he or she eats bacon, ham, sausage, or pork chops." Tessler adds that pork "should be considered a homo-toxin (human poison) and the probable cause of many common sicknesses and degenerative diseases." 4

Pigs (ctd.)

Genetic Similarity Between Humans and Pigs (98 perc match)

Research has shown that pigs have similar immune systems, metabolic processes, and organ systems to humans, making them suitable for studying diseases such as cardiovascular disorders, diabetes, and organ transplantation. By analyzing the genetic similarity between humans and pigs, scientists can gain insights into the underlying mechanisms of diseases and develop new therapies.

Rabbits

The rabbit is coprophagic—an animal that consumes its own excrement. 18 Consequently, the toxicity levels of rabbits are significantly higher than in other herbivores. Bile salts, fatty acids, gases, and ammonia levels are all at unacceptable levels for human consumption. Many other rodents have similar digestive issues. source as above

Other Unclean Animals

The common denominator seems to be the fact that unclean animals habitually eat flesh that would normally sicken or kill humans. By contrast, clean animals almost exclusively consume "primary" materials—various forms of plant life. Moreover, clean animals never eat dead animals or animal byproducts.

It is apparent that God created numerous unclean animals for the express purpose of cleaning up after other animals. Calling them the "sanitation workers of our ecology," nutritionist David Meinz writes: "Could it be that God, in His wisdom, created certain creatures whose sole purpose is to clean up after the others?"26 source as above

Shellfish

Shellfish are bivalve filter feeders and thus rapidly accumulate toxins produced by microscopic algae such as dinoflagellates, diatoms, and cyanobacteria. The toxicity levels of marine bed algae are often seasonal: when the algae of a given area are in "bloom," the toxicity is high; shellfish that feed on such algae become highly toxic.20 However, it is important to understand that such toxins are a normal byproduct of their existence. In other words, shellfish are always toxic, and have the potential to become dangerously toxic at any time. Source as above

Birds

As a rule, unclean birds are predatory—those that kill and eat other animals—or are scavengers, such as the vulture, that eat carrion. Most of them are listed by name or genus in Leviticus 11 as unclean. Generally, clean birds are herbivores; however, farm birds such as chickens do eat a certain amount of small bugs and worms— and ducks eat small fish. (On most commercial poultry farms today, chickens are fed fishmeal or carcass meal—processed dead animals—which raises questions as to their suitability for human consumption.) Source as above

Acts 15:4-21
