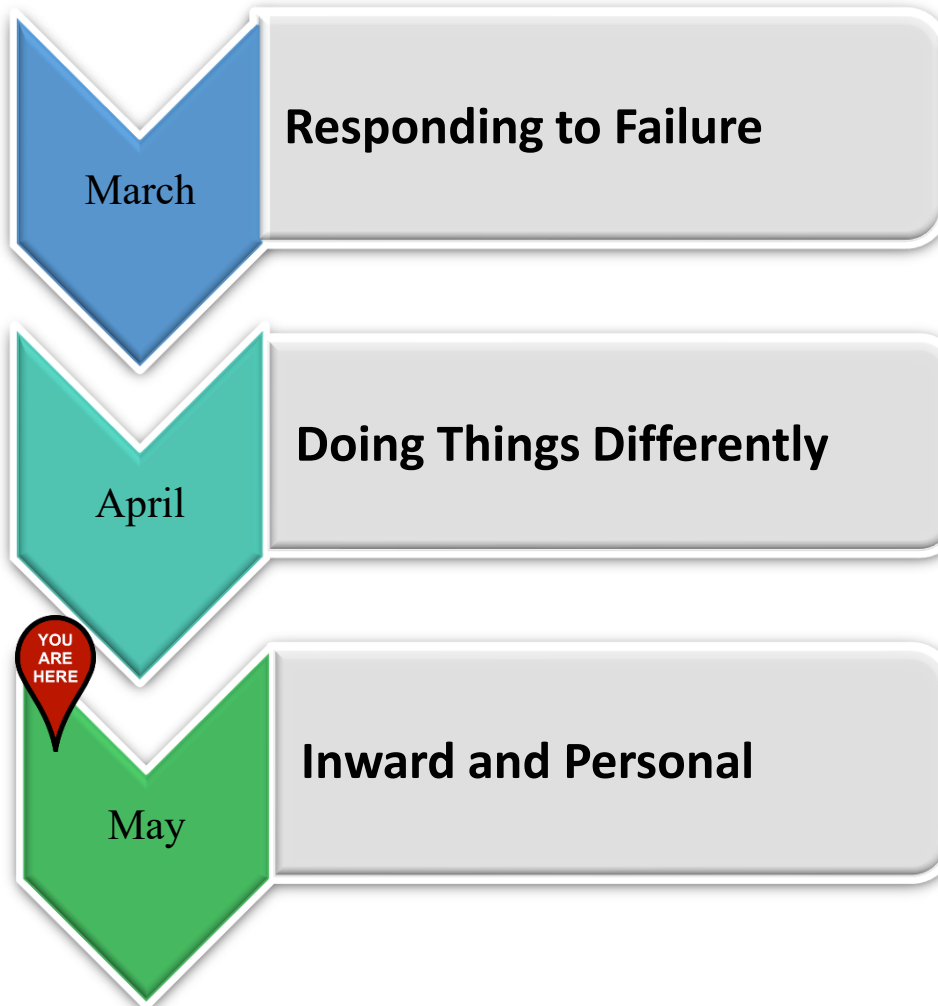

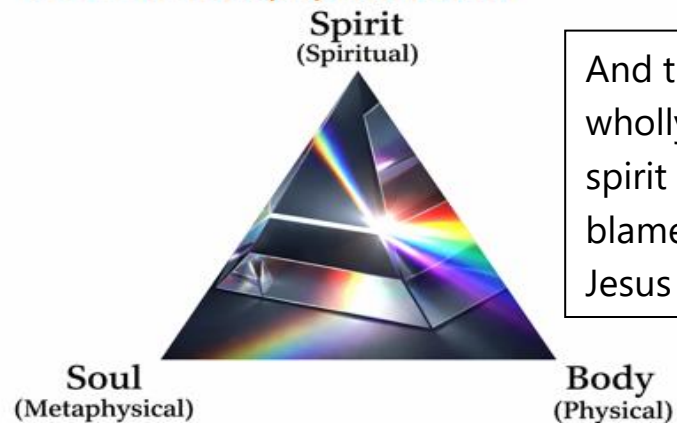
Overcoming the Evil

- The distinction between sin and evil.
 - Not always clear, but helps our understanding.
 - Evil is the veil that separates us from God so we cannot see him clearly.
 - It is more of a potential to do 'wrong'.
 - If we can let it lie still it will lose its strength.
 - Sin is evil in action. It is the things we do that further separate us from God.

 - Paul sets out 2 laws in Romans 8. 'For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.'
- Romans 8:2**

Let us look further into these 2 Laws

- Life force “brings life to your being”
- Spiritual awareness
- Spiritual influence
- Communicates back to the spiritual realm from the metaphysical realm

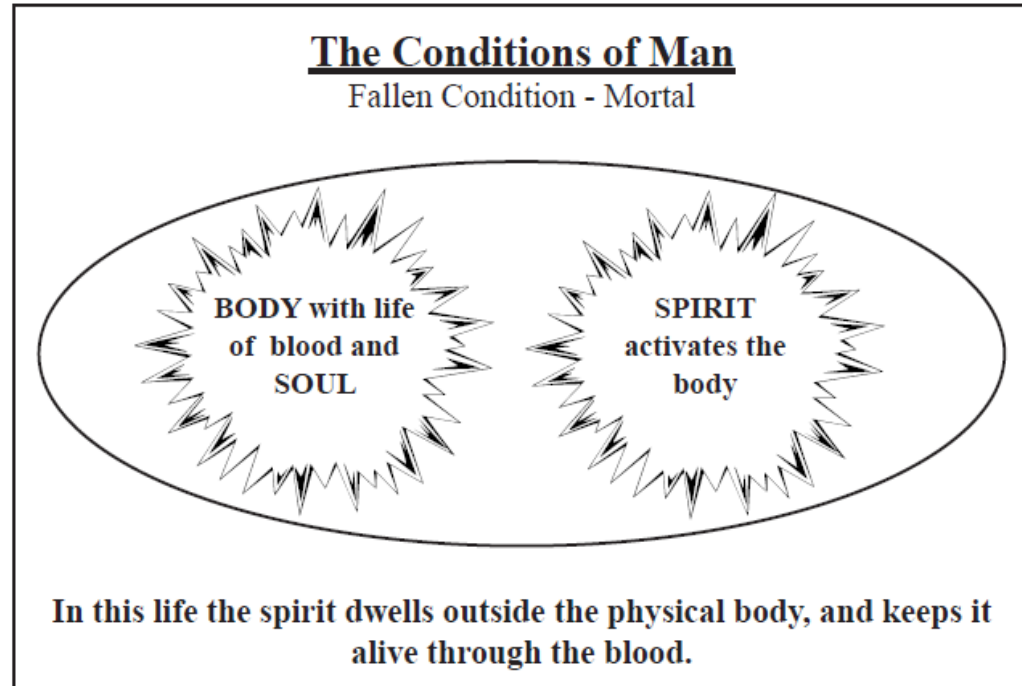

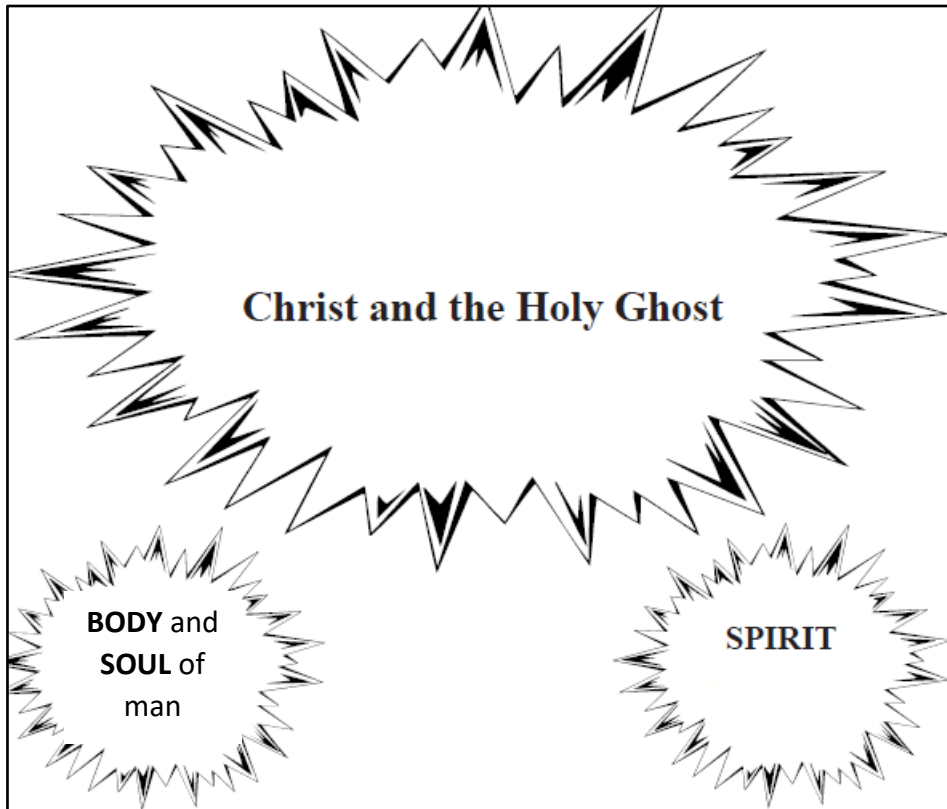


21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.

¹ There is therefore now **no condemnation** to them which are in Christ Jesus, **who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.**

² For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

³ For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, **God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh,**

and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: ⁴ That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. **Romans 8:1-4**

Isaiah 1:12-20

A righteous attitude and heartfelt meaning are more important to God than the ritual prescribed by the law. Samuel told King Saul years before that, 'Obedience is better than sacrifice' 1 Samuel 15:22

¹² When ye come to appear before me, who hath required this at your hand, to tread my courts? ¹³ Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting.

¹⁴ Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear them. ¹⁵ And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood.

¹⁶ Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; ¹⁷ Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.
