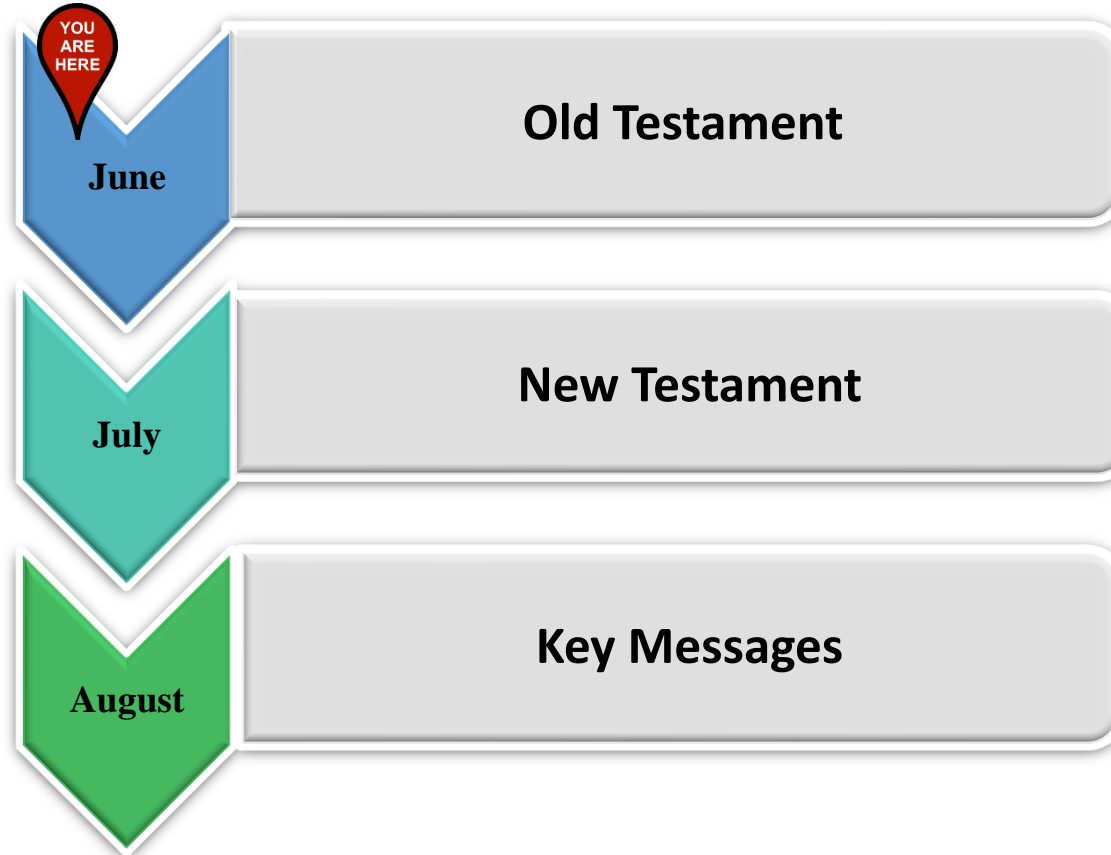
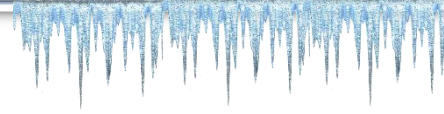

# Old Testament Prophets: Key Messages

Grouping the prophetic books by their main themes



## 1. Call to Repentance and Return

*God calls His people to turn back to Him in obedience and covenant faithfulness.*

Isaiah ♦ Jeremiah ♦ Hosea ♦ Joel  
Amos ♦ Micah ♦ Zephaniah ♦ Malachi



## 2. Warning of Judgment

*The prophets warn of coming punishment for sin, idolatry, injustice, and rebellion.*

Isaiah ♦ Jeremiah ♦ Ezekiel ♦ Amos  
Habakkuk ♦ Zephaniah ♦ Nahum ♦ Obadiah



## 3. Hope, Restoration, and Return

*God promises mercy, restoration, return from exile, and renewed blessing.*

Isaiah ♦ Jeremiah ♦ Ezekiel ♦ Hosea ♦ Joel  
Amos ♦ Micah ♦ Zephaniah  
Haggai ♦ Zechariah ♦ Malachi



## 4. Messiah, Future Kingdom, and the Day of the Lord

*The prophets look forward to the coming King, God's kingdom, and the great day of the Lord.*

Isaiah ♦ Daniel ♦ Joel  
Micah ♦ Zechariah ♦ Malachi



## 5. Messages to Nations and Empires

*Some prophets speak directly to foreign nations or about God's rule over all nations.*

Obadiah (*Edom*) ♦ Jonah (*Nineveh*) ♦ Nahum (*Nineveh*)  
Daniel (*world empires*) ♦ Isaiah (*many nations*)  
Jeremiah (*many nations*) ♦ Ezekiel (*many nations*)



## 6. Temple, Worship, and Rebuilding

*Post-exilic prophets urge renewed worship, holiness, and rebuilding after exile.*

Haggai ♦ Zechariah ♦ Malachi



## LAMENTATIONS

*A poetic lament over Jerusalem's fall, closely tied to Jeremiah's message of judgment and sorrow.*

Many prophetic books contain more than one key message, so some books appear in multiple groups.

Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel.



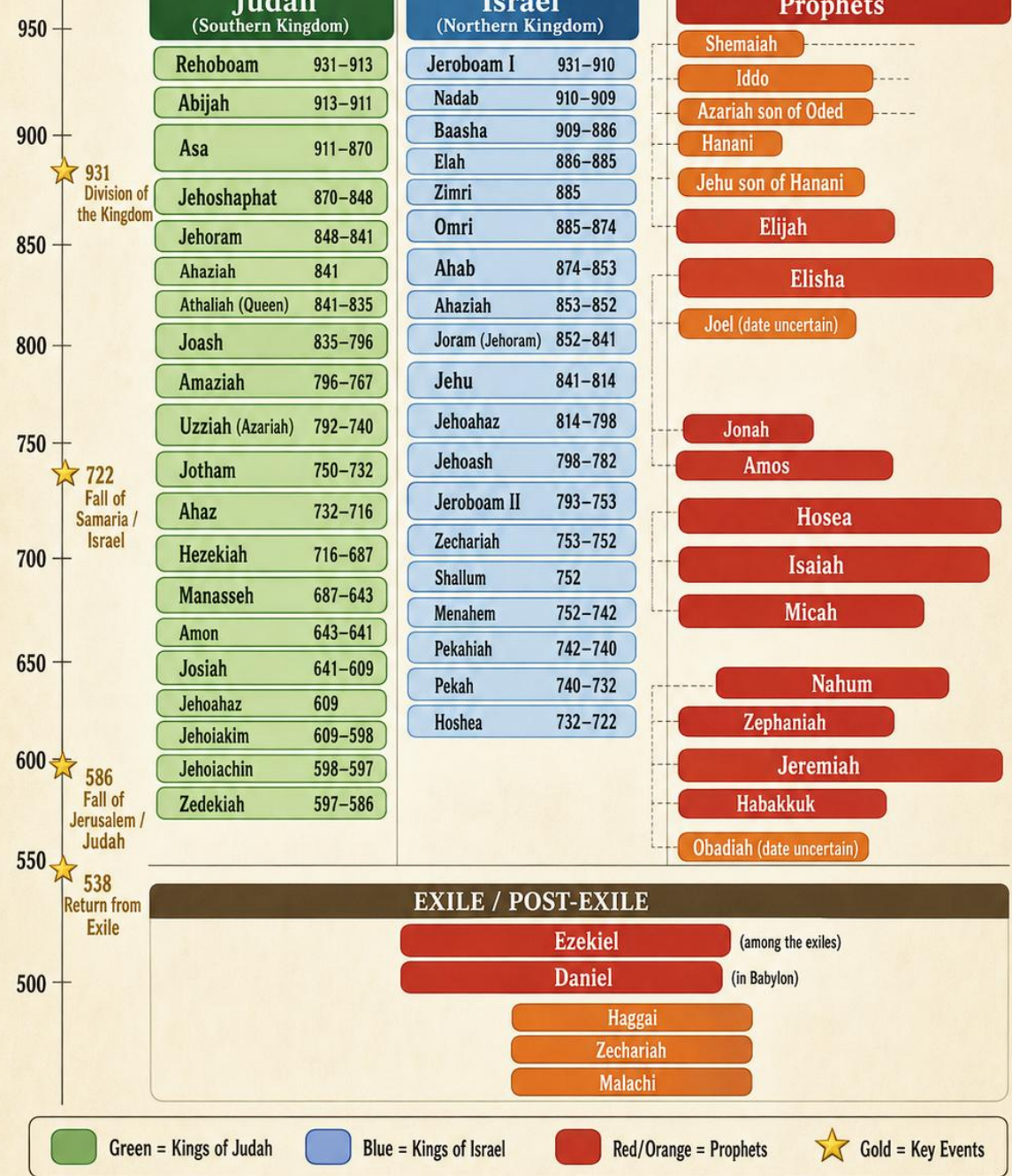
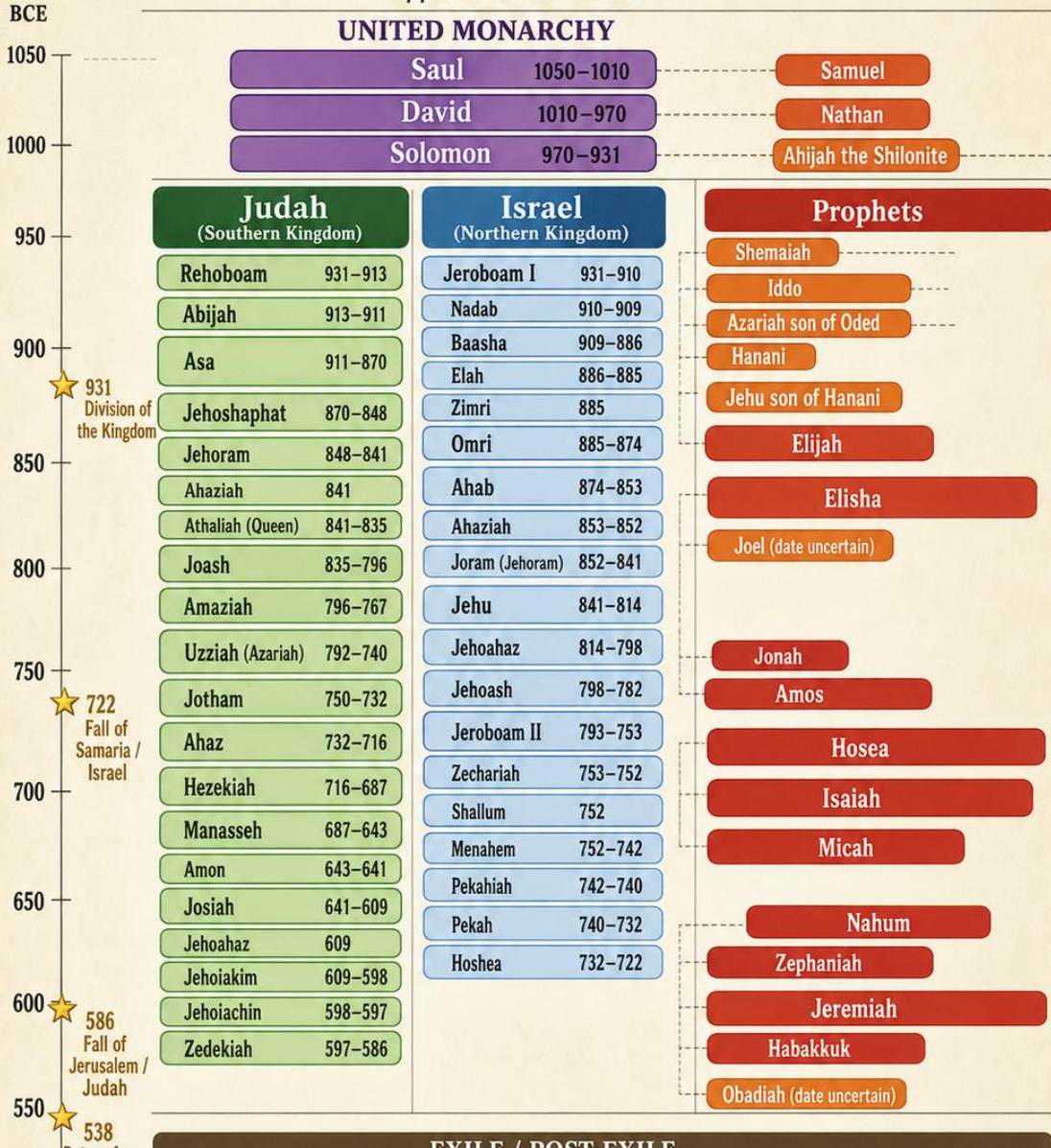

7. He would suffer for sin and be exalted
  - ch's 52–53

- Prophesies the massacre of the innocents
  - ch 31:15

### Ezekiel

- Contains the worst chapter in the Bible
  - ch 23
- Inspired the song dem bones
  - ch 37

### Daniel

- The Lions Den
- The Fiery Furnace
- Prophecies of Kingdoms to come
  - ch 7

## A Few Standouts

### Jonah

- Was disobedient to his order
- Swallowed by a fish
- Ends his book with a reprimand from God

### Micah

- Prophesies the birthplace of Jesus
  - ch 5:2
- Provides the famous walk with God verse
  - ch 6:8

### Amos

- Teaches us that everything happens according to God's plan "shall there be evil in a city and the Lord hath not done it?"
  - ch 3:6

### Malachi

- Tells of the messenger of the Covenant
  - ch 3:1
- Prophesies the coming of "Elijah"
  - ch 4:5-6

## Hebrews 11:32-40

**Those for whom the world is not worthy**

And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, **and of the prophets:**

<sup>33</sup> Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, **stopped the mouths of lions.**

<sup>34</sup> **Quenched the violence of fire,** escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

<sup>35</sup> **Women received their dead raised to life again:** and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

<sup>36</sup> And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover **of bonds and imprisonment:**

<sup>37</sup> They were stoned, **they were sawn asunder,** were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;

<sup>38</sup> **(Of whom the world was not worthy:)** they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.

<sup>39</sup> And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:

<sup>40</sup> **God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.**

## Zechariah Chapter 3

### The Many Brethren

And he shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the Lord, and Satan standing at his right hand to resist him.

<sup>2</sup> And the Lord said unto Satan, **The Lord rebuke thee, O Satan**; even the Lord that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: is not this a brand plucked out of the fire?

<sup>3</sup> Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel.

<sup>4</sup> And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, **Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.**

<sup>5</sup> And I said, **Let them set a fair mitre upon his head.** So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the Lord stood by.

<sup>8</sup> Hear now, O Joshua the high priest, thou, and thy fellows that sit before thee: for they are men wondered at: for, behold, I will bring forth my servant the Branch.

<sup>9</sup> For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the Lord of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.
