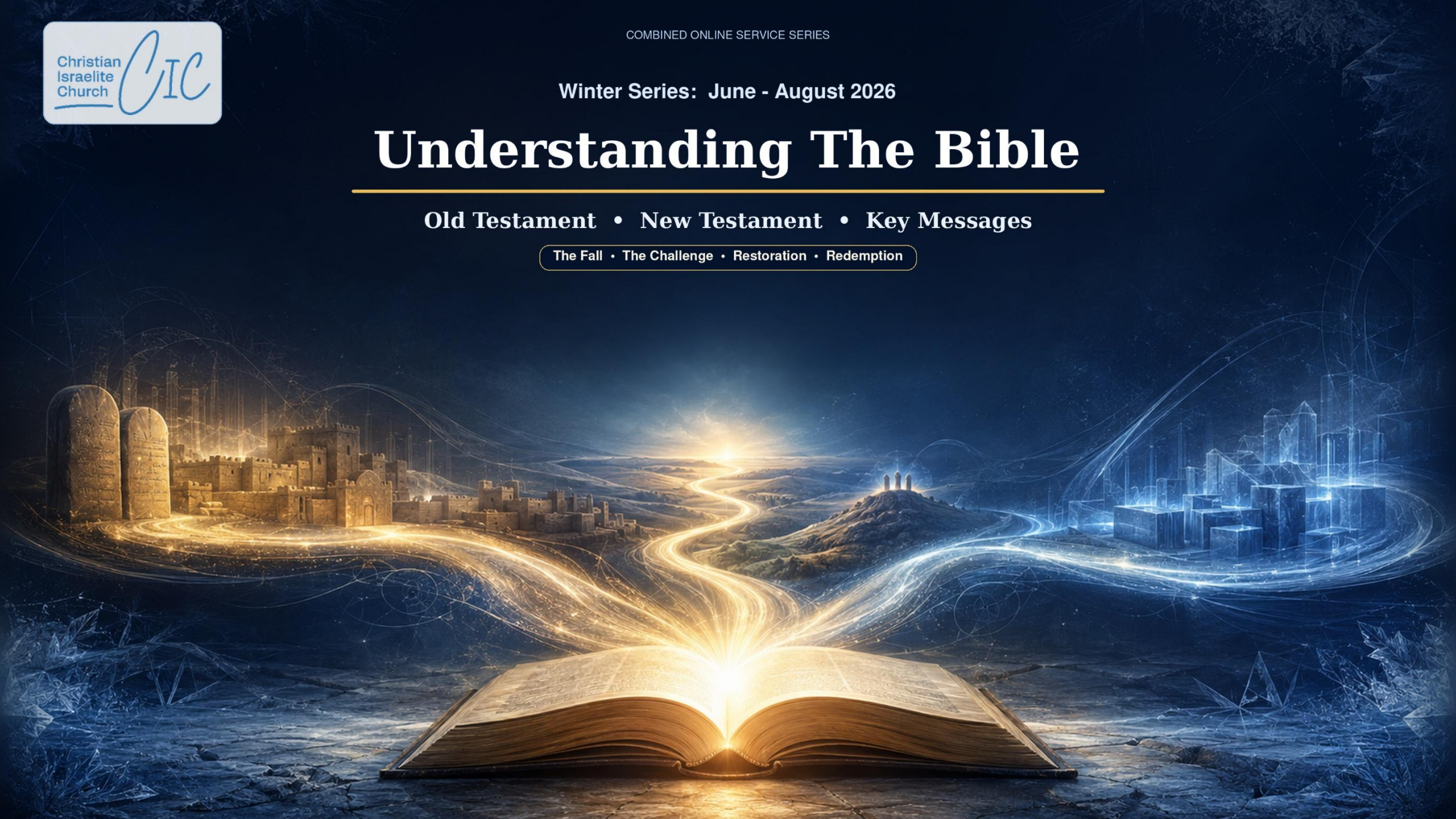

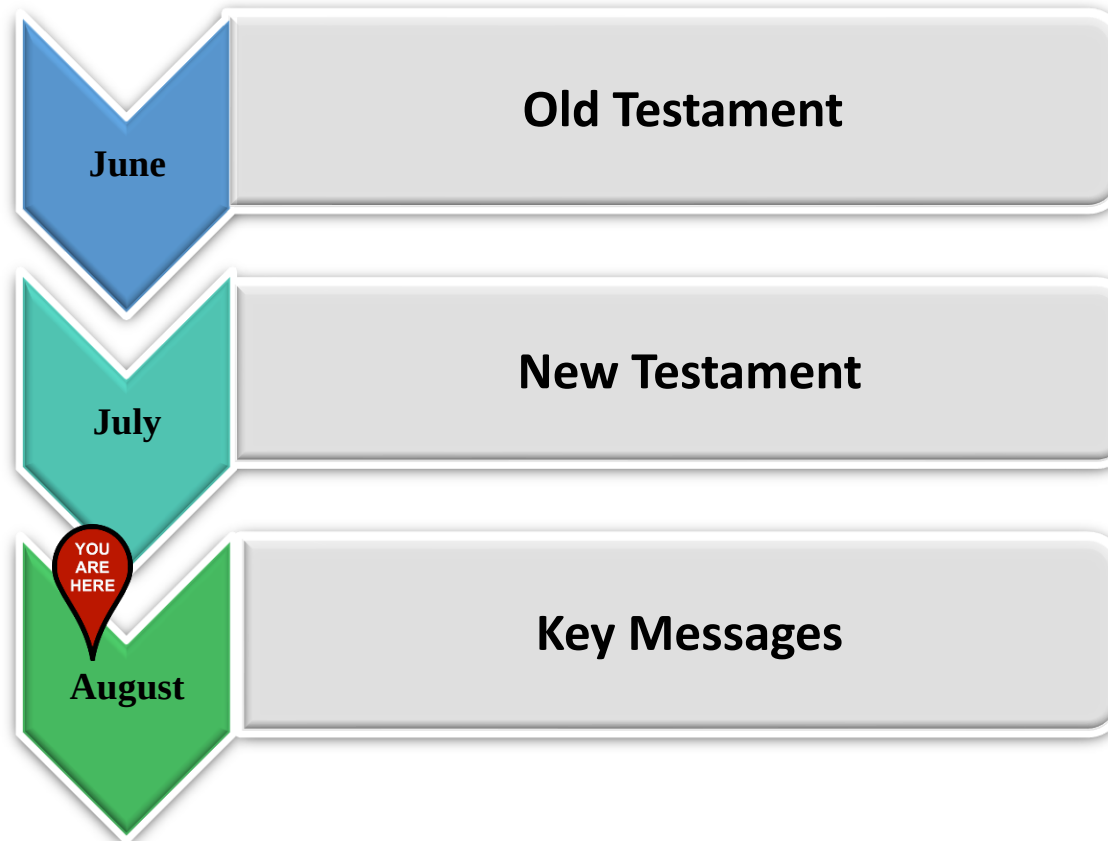

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

⁴ Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

⁵ And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.

⁶ And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

⁷ But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

⁸ For to one is given by the Spirit **the word of wisdom**; to another **the word of knowledge** by the same Spirit;

⁹ To another **faith** by the same Spirit; to another the **gifts of healing** by the same Spirit;

¹⁰ To another the **working of miracles**; to another **prophecy**; to another **discerning of spirits**; to another **divers kinds of tongues**; to another the **interpretation of tongues**:

¹¹ But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.



A Closer look at the Gifts

1. The Word of Wisdom

➤ King Solomon and the two mothers

*“And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore.
And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.
For he was wiser than all men;...” 1 Kings 4:29-31*

2. The Word of Understanding

➤ Elisha and the King of Syria

*“Then the king of Syria warred against Israel, and took counsel with his servants, saying, In such and such a place shall be my camp.
And the man of God sent unto the king of Israel, saying, Beware that thou pass not such a place; for thither the Syrians are come down.
And the king of Israel sent to the place which the man of God told him and warned him of, and saved himself there, not once nor twice.
Therefore the heart of the king of Syria was sore troubled for this thing; and he called his servants, and said unto them, Will ye not shew me which of us is for the king of Israel?
And one of his servants said, None, my lord, O king: but Elisha, the prophet that is in Israel, telleth the king of Israel the words that thou speakest in thy bedchamber.” 2 Kings 6:8-12*

A Closer look at the Gifts

3. Faith

- Elijah on Mt Carmel

“And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, and that I have done all these things at thy word.

Hear me, O Lord, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the Lord God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again.

Then the fire of the Lord fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench.”

1 Kings 18:36-38

4. Gifts of Healing

- Elisha heals Naaman of leprosy
2 Kings 5:1–14
- Peter and John heal the lame man at the temple
Acts 3:1–10
- Paul heals Publius’ father and others on Malta
Acts 28:7–9

“Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick. And he said unto them, Take nothing for your journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.

And whatsoever house ye enter into, there abide, and thence depart. And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.

And they departed, and went through the towns, preaching the gospel, and healing every where..”

Luke 9:1-6

6. Prophecy

- Agabus prophesy's a famine in Israel
Acts 11:27–30
- Many people (including Agabus) prophesy of the imprisonment of Paul on his way to Jerusalem
Acts 20 - 21

“And in these days came prophets from Jerusalem unto Antioch.

And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.

Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea:

Which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.”

Acts 11:27-30

A Closer look at the Gifts

7. Discerning of Spirits

- Paul and the slave girl in Philippi
Acts 16:16–18

“And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.”

Acts 16:16-18

8. Divers kinds of Tongues

- The Apostles preaching at Pentecost
Acts 2:4

“And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language.”

Acts 2:3-6

9. Interpretation of Tongues

“If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three... and let one interpret.”

1 Corinthians 14:27

⁷ To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

⁸ First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.

⁹ For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers;

¹⁰ Making request, if by any means now at length I might have a prosperous journey by the will of God to come unto you.

¹¹ For I long to see you, *that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end ye may be established;*

Luke 15:8,9

⁸ Either what woman having **ten pieces of silver**, **if she lose one piece**, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find it?

⁹ And when she hath found it, she calleth her friends and her neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.

- Though the Apostles had the ability to give these gifts of the spirit, it appears that this was not able to be passed on again
- **The piece was lost in the Fall of Man** – The Spirits of God (Christ and the Holy Ghost)

1 Corinthians 13:7-11

Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.

² And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.

³ And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.

⁴ Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up;

⁵ Does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil;

⁶ Does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;

⁷ Bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

⁸ Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away.

⁹ For we know in part and we prophesy in part.

¹⁰ **But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away.**

¹¹ When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

¹² For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part, but **then I shall know just as I also am known.**

¹³ And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.
